

- Participants to the Regional Advancement Opportunities are Seniors Scouts who have not earned any rank in the Senior Scouting Program. Each Local Council is entitled to have 15 slots with the Deputy Council Program Commissioner for Senior Scouting and other adult leaders of the Scouts joining the activity.
- Council Scout Executives shall send scouts who are interested to go up in the ladder of advancement and willing to take the challenges of the various activities embodied in earning the highest rank of advancement in the Senior Scouting Program.
- 4. The twelve Senior Scouts shall come from various school preferably two representatives from a Secondary School for a more lively discussion.
- Scouts attending the activity shall download the Senior Scout Advancement Passport and the Merit Badge Application Form.
