

SUBJECT: **IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM (SBFP)
NUTRITIOUS FOOD PRODUCTS/ MILK FEEDING COMPONENT 2022**

PARTICULARS

1. Pursuant to Republic Act No. 11037 known as "**Masustansyang Pagkain para sa Batang Pilipino Act**" and DepEd Order No. 31, s. 2021, **Operational Guidelines on the Implementation of School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP)-Milk Feeding Program Component**" and supplemented by DO no.10, s. 2022, this office shall implement the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) Nutritious Food Products – Milk Feeding Component. The SBFP's primary beneficiaries for FY 2022, shall be the same beneficiaries (All kindergarten learners, and the Grade 1 to Grade 6 Learners who were wasted (W) and severely wasted (SW) based on the SY 2021-2022 SBFP.
2. The number of feeding days shall be 30 days for Nutritious Food Products (NFP) and 16 days for Pasteurized Milk and the suggested implementation period is within April to July of SY 2021-2022 both for the NFP and MFC components thus, the number of feeding days for SY 2021-2022 using FY's 2021 and 2022 Funds is 90 days for NFP and 49 days for Milk for a total of 139 days.
3. The program primarily aims to support the SBFP by providing fresh milk as supplement and NFP, the ready-to-eat food packs given to underweight learners, develop milk-drinking habit among the beneficiaries, improve nutritional status and address undernutrition and hunger especially during this COVID-19 pandemic.

4. The Schools Division Office, through Schools Governance Operations Division (SGOD) – School Health Section (SHS) shall endeavor to collaborate with the Philippine Carabao Center (PCC) Island Office for the delivery of fresh milk through a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) including services for production, quality assurance, processing, packaging, logistics and delivery of fresh milk.
5. Relative to this, all elementary schools shall ensure the readiness to receive, handle and store the fresh milk which are packed in food-grade polyethylene pouches and Nutritious Food Products. An orientation shall be announced on a scheduled date to discuss various details of implementation, including its mechanics of delivery and receipt by the schools, timelines, storage, handling, accounting, risks management, forms, reporting and recording system, duties and responsibilities, monitoring and evaluation, among others.
