

SDO-Dagupan City EMPLOYEES SPORTSFEST

(1st Superintendent Cup 2022)

DATE:

11 April 2022

- 1. This office will conduct the SDO-Dagupan City Employees Sportsfest and dubbed as the 1st Superintendents Cup 2022. This activity is part of the SDO-Dagupan City Employee's Physical Fitness, Wellness and Sports Program and aligned to the Physical Fitness Program for Government Personnel embodied in CSC Memorandum Circular No. 38, s. 1992 and CSC MC No.8, s.2011 which is "The Great Filipino Workout". Taking advantage of the ongoing Progressive F2F classes where learners are not yet allowed to engage in other extracurricular activities and the health and safety protocols will be strictly observed.
- 2. This activity will be participated by teaching, non-teaching personnel and officials of this division. It is FRIENDLY Competition, and that active participation is first and winning second. The schools are grouped/clustered to balance and complement each other's composition/organization of the different delegations/teams. (Pls refer to attached list)
- 3. The activity will be officially opened on April 29, 2022, at 7:30AM, at the Don Alipio Fernandez, Sr. People's Astrodome. After a short Opening Program, it will be preceded by the SEARCH for Ginoo, Binibi at Ikatlong Lahi. In the afternoon the Larong Pinoy will be played at the Bonuan Boquig ES Covered Gym and athletic grounds, at 2:00PM-5:30PM. Succeeding games will be held in different playing venues on approved dates and time.
- 4. The activity will be managed by the SGOD with support from the CID, the DCPSTEA and all the School/District Sports Coordinators. They will be assisted by the different Game Managers, accredited Technical Officials and Team Leaders. (Pls refer to the attached list)
- 5. The submission of ENTRIES to the Secretariat c/o SGOD is until April 22, 2022.
- All school heads are enjoined to support this program/activity as it geared towards a healthy and productive workforce.
- 7. Wide and immediate dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

SDO-DAGUPAN CITY EMPLOYEES PHYSICAL FITNESS, WELLNESS AND SPORTS PROGRAM

RATIONALE:

One of the famous English cleric and jurist named Henricus Bracton once said, "An ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure," and "Mens sana in corpore sano" (a healthy mind in a healthy body) which was coined by the Roman poet Juvenal. It is along this thought that the Employees Physical Fitness, Wellness and Sports Program at the Schools Division Office of Dagupan City (SDO-DC) was conceptualized to look after the physical well-being of the SDO workforce (teaching and non-teaching personnel, including officials) through the development and maintenance of a program most especially in this hard times brought about by the COVID-19, and that consist of several components to be implemented this April 29 to June 2022 and the ensuing months/years.

Managers and leaders alike recognize the importance of a healthy workforce most especially in this time of the pandemic. It has been always said that human resources are the most valuable resource and the lifeblood of an organization. The Civil Service Commission (CSC) as the central personnel agency of the government, issued CSC Memorandum Circular No. 38, s. 1992 regarding the "Physical and Mental Fitness Program for Government Personnel" and MC No. 6, s. 1995 and MC No. 8, s. 2011 requires, reiterates and adopts the implementation of all agencies the "Great Filipino Workout" as an integral part of the National Physical Fitness and Sports Development Program for government personnel for a continuing physical fitness and sports activities.

OBJECTIVES:

A. GENERAL:

To develop a healthy and productive workforce at the SDO-Dagupan City.

B. SPECIFICS:

- To promote the importance of developing and maintaining a happy, healthy lifestyle through continuous physical fitness activities.
- 2. To participate in health and wellness programs.
- 3. To actively participate in sports activities or tournaments.
- 4. To improve and strengthen inter-personal relationships among the entire workforces.
- 5. To improve work performance.

PROJECT TITLE: SDO-DAGUPAN CITY EMPLOYEES SPORTSFEST 1st Superintendent's Cup 2022

Specific RULES AND GUIDELINES

A. PLAYERS' ELIGIBILITY:

- The sports fest is open to all qualified employees (teaching/non-teaching) of the SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICE and its field offices/schools.
- The employee-player shall have an employment status as permanent/regular; contractual/job
 order employees maybe qualified if his/her appointment was made/approved before March
 2022. Must be an employee of the Basic Education Department only (for schools with college
 levels).

- 3. Proof of employment shall be submitted:
 - a. Certified Xeroxed copy of original appointment.
 - b. Certified Xeroxed copy of payroll (at least 3 months).
- Must be physically fit as certified by the division medical officer or in the absence, any gov't physician.

B. TEAM COMPOSITION:

- BASKETBALL (for male teacher-personnel)- a team may compose of minimum of 10 and maximum of 18 team members PLUS 1-coach/team manager.
- VOLLEYBALL (for men and women teacher-personnel category)- a team may compose maximum of 12 team members (including 2 libero) and 1-coach/team manager).
- 3. BADMINTON/TABLE TENNIS/TENNIS (for MEN and WOMEN *Teacher/Personnel* categories) –a team may compose of four (4) men and four (4) women and 1-Coach/event
- 4. CHESS Open Category: 2-men; 2-women.
- 5. LARONG PINOY (Teaching/ non-teaching personnel):
 - a. Patintero 2 men, 2 women (Categories: Below 45, 45 and above)
 - b. **Tug of War** 4 men, 4 women (1. *Teacher category*: Required COMBINED total WEIGHT of the 8 team members shall be 600 kgs. or less; 2. *Personnel category*: No weight limit; 3. *LGBTQ+*: Open category)
 - c. Sack Race 5 men, 5 women (1. Teacher; 2. Personnel Categories: Under 45 and 45 and above; LGBTQ+: Open Category).
 - d. Kadang-kadang (coconut husk) (Open Categories: Under 45; 45 and above), ten (10) members (5-men, 5-women) /team/category.
 - e. Tumbang Preso (Open Category)- 4 players/team (mixed gender)
 - f. Siatong (Open Category) 4 players/team (mixed gender)
 - g. Palo Sebo-(Open category) 5 players per team.

C. PLAYING PROCEDURES:

BASKETBALL:

- In the 1st and 2nd periods or 1st HALF, ALL PLAYERS should have played. Unless a player is INJURED and or not fit to play.
 - PENALTY: Technical Foul: 2 freethrows for every physical present player not fielded in the 1st Half. Exemption: Player/s is injured/absent/dropped(withdrawn).
- 2. The 2nd half maybe played by any of the team members/players. Normal substitution procedure is observed.
- Format: Bracketed round robin (elimination round); DRAWLOTS for semifinal round (top team in each group/bracket; Finals-knockout game.

VOLLEYBALL:

- 1. All games shall be played in three (3) sets.
- 2. The game winner is determined by the total points scored in 3 sets.
- 3. In the 1st and 2nd sets, all the 12 players + 2 liberos shall have played (the first 6 players with the 1st libero and then second 6 players plus the 2nd libero). Substitution shall be among the 6 players only. Physically present players NOT fielded shall be penalized with a loss of service. Exemption: player/s is injured/absent/withdrawn.

4. The 3rd set maybe played by any among the 12 players. Normal substitution is observed.

Format: Bracketed round robin (eliminations); DRAWLOTS for semifinals (top team in each group/bracket; Finals-knockout game.

BADMINTON/TABLE TENNIS (Open)

1. 8-players (4-male; 4-female) players per delegation. Competition shall be Singles/Doubles/Singles matches only. All games shall be played in Single Eliminations.

CHESS (Open)

1. 4 - players (2-male; 2-female); To be played by means of the SWISS ROUND System.

<u>SWIMMING.</u> Relay category (mixed gender) Open category. To use the 25-meter pool. <u>MTB Cycling.</u> Open Category.

TENNIS: 8-Players (4-men; 4-Women). The format will depend on the number of entries.

SELECTION of SDO-DC Ginoo/Bb./Ikatlong Lahi.

 Qualifications for Ginoo/Bb SDO-DC must be SINGLE, while the Ikatlong Lahi is OPEN (married/single).

TEAM UNIFORM:

- Complete Uniform by teams is OPTIONAL, for as long as the upper shirt is the color assigned to each delegation/team. The committee though will not discourage teams to have complete set of playing uniforms.
- 2. Teams shall use the assigned team colors as drawn and agreed upon by the sports coordinators.
- 3. Playing numbers may be 0, 00, 1-99 for BASKETBALL, 1-12 for VOLLEYBALL
- The playing shirt shall bear number front and back, while in the shorts, should be in front (volleyball/basketball).

GAME/SPORTS RULES TO GOVERN THE SPORTSFEST

- The specific sports rules as set by their respective Federations and its amendments will be used/applied in this sportsfest, unless it is specifically defined in the Rules and Guidelines set forth.
- The rules for the Larong Pinoy are adopted from the DepED Rules and Regulations and as agreed by the competing teams and to be properly discussed during technical meetings.
- 3. The decision of the Technical Committee/Referees is FINAL.

PLAYING SCHEDULES:

The regular playing day/schedule will be every FRIDAY afternoon starting at 3:00pm or as may be approved by the SDS and during holidays and or Saturdays as may eb agreed by the participating teams.

The OPENING PROGRAM will be a WHOLE DAY activity on April 29, 2022, starting at 6:30AM to be followed by the games in Larong Pinoy and to culminate with the pageantry. The VENUE will be at the Bonuan Boquig ES covered gym and athletic ground.

FUNDING SOURCE:

The operational expenses in the conduct of this project shall be sourced through sponsorships, solicitations, and donations from the DCPSTEA, business establishments, construction companies, benevolent/philanthropic friends, and shared responsibility of participants/players in the sports categories.
