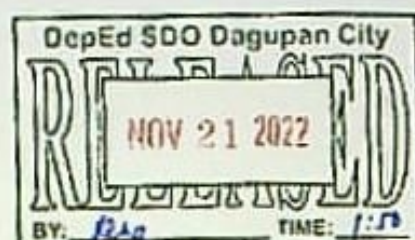

Date : November 21, 2022

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 479, signed on October 25, 1994, entitled "Declaring the Month of November of Every Year as Filipino Values Month," The SDO-Dagupan City in cooperation with the Inner Wheel of Dagupan-District 379 join the 2022 Filipino Values Month.
2. Relative to this, a Culmination Program will be held on November 29, 2022 at the Division Training Center @ 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon with the theme, "Magandang Kaugaliang Filipino: Isabuhay at Pagyamanin Tungo sa Matiwasay at Maunlad na Kinabukasan," in cooperation with the Inner Wheel Club of Dagupan City.
3. The activity aims to :
  - a. promote values that are remarkably and emphatically Filipino,
  - b. incorporate values in activities such as poem recitation, essay writing, poster and slogan making,
  - c. immerse the learners in personal study of God's Word, and
  - d. encourage learners to learn from others and compete on their own skills and expertise.
4. In line with this, the following will be contested after the opening program;
  - a. Poem Recitation - Grade 1 or 2 (DTC)
  - b. Bible Quiz Bee - Grade 3 or 4 (DTC)

- c. Essay Writing – Grade 5 (WCES 1-Home Economics Bldg.)
  - d. Poster-Slogan Making – Grade 6 (WCES 1-Home Economics Bldg.)
5. Enclosed are the List of Technical Working Group, Contest Facilitators and Members, Contest Mechanics and Guidelines and the Criteria for Judging.
  6. All Chairpersons and Co-Chairpersons of the Technical Working Groups and Contest Facilitators will have a general meeting on November 23, 2022 at 4:00 o'clock in the afternoon at the DTC.
  7. Activities relative to the observance of FVM shall be held in accordance with DepEd Order No. 9, s.2005, titled "Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On Task and Ensuring compliance therewith DO. 34, s. 2022, titled (School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2022-2023."

- The contestant is only allowed to use pastel colors as a medium and may use pencil pen for outlining and writing the slogan. The poster could be in landscape or portrait orientation.
- They will be given 2 hours to finish their output. In case the contestant came late on the time of the contest started, he or she may still join but will only be given the only remaining time of the contest to finish his or her work.
- The contestant may wear their uniform or any attire for their comfortability during the contest but have to wear their school ID.
- The outputs will be judge with the given criteria and will be the property of the event coordinator.
- The top three (3) winners will receive cash prizes and Certificate of Recognition. The none winners will receive Certificate of Participation.

<b>Relevance to the Theme</b> The design must express the theme directly to the point and captivate the judges' senses.	<b>40%</b>
<b>Visual Impact or Aesthetic Appeal</b> The poster design must give an outstanding reaction to the judges. Coloring, Neatness, Balance, etcetera.	<b>30%</b>

- The contestants must be given one (1) hour and thirty (30) minutes to develop the composition with not more than 250 words.
- The composition must be written in Filipino.
- The contestants shall be provided with a pen and paper marked with the assigned number duly signed by the contest facilitator. They are prohibited to write their names and school they are representing.
- No other materials can be seen on the table during the competition except for the given pen and marked paper.
- A number is assigned to each contestant.
- The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.
- The top three (3) winners will receive cash prizes and Certificate of Recognition. The none winners will receive Certificate of Participation.

### **BIBLE QUIZ BEE**

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

The competition is for bonafide Grade 3 or 4 learners. There shall be a total of sixteen (16) contestants from the public schools, TWO (2) contestants per district.

#### **GUIDELINES**

- The quiz bee shall cover general information parts of the Bible Structures, Narratives, Personages, Books and Significant Events etc.
- There are three (3) rounds in the competition namely;
  1. Easy
  2. Average
  3. Difficult

In case of a tie, a Clincher round will take place.

- The EASY category has ten (10) questions, 1 point each. The AVERAGE category has five (5) questions, 2 points each and the DIFFICULT category has three (3) questions, 5 points each.
- Coaches/trainers shall submit **three (3) questions** for each category and one **(1) question** for the CLINCHER round. Questions will be submitted to the contest facilitator before the start of the quiz bee.

All questions must be computer encoded in ¼ lengthwise using A4 size coupon bond in Arial font of 14 pt. Indicate the reference (When citing a passage of scripture, include the abbreviated name of the book, the chapter number, and the verse number and the edition), URL and links from the online references are also required. Refrain from using WIKIPEDIA website and other unreliable online sources.

The type of questions in each round shall be;

1. Easy round- multiple choice with four (4) options
  2. Average round – Fill in the blanks
  3. Difficult round – Identification
  4. Clincher round – combination of the 3 types of questions
- A Quiz master will read the questions twice and the contestants will write their answers on the given materials to them (a white board and a marker/sheets of paper and a pen) in the allotted time for each question.

Easy – 10 seconds

Average – 30 seconds

Difficult – 60 seconds

Clincher – Depends on the difficulty of the question and to be decided upon by the board of judges.

The time will only start after the quiz master says "GO." The contestants may start writing their answer as the question is being read but will have to wait for the signal before they raise/show their answer. Misspelled answer is wrong and has no point.

If a contestant wishes to change his/her answer, he/she must cross out his/her previous answer and the final answer must be encircled. This must be done within the allotted time and have to raise/show his/her answer after the signal was given. Failure to do so means his/her answer is deemed INVALID/INCORRECT.

- Each contestant must keep his/her whiteboard raised or shown unless the quiz master or proctor has acknowledged the answer and has requested to put the whiteboard down.
- In case of question as regards to the correctness/validity of an answer, the Board of Judges will determine the validity of the answer. The coach/trainer can also provide a references/sources that can validate the correctness/validity of the answer.
- Protest/s regarding a question or answer must be done right after the particular question. Once the next question has been read, protest/s regarding the previous question will no longer be entertained. Protest/s may only be raised by the duly registered coach/trainer. Decisions of the Board of Judges is FINAL and IRREVOCABLE.
- The winners will be declared after the scores in the three (3) rounds are added. The contestant with the highest score will be awarded FIRST PLACE, the second highest score as the SECOND PLACE and the third highest score as the THIRD PLACE.
- In case of a tie, CLINCHER round will be played. This will be a knockout system among the contestants tied for a particular spot until a winner emerges.



- The top three (3) winners will receive cash prizes and Certificate of Recognition. The none winners will receive Certificate of Participation.
