

Specific Guidelines of Each Event Skills Exhibition

EVENT TITLE	Qur'an Reading		
NO, OF PARTICIPANTS	One (1)		
TIME ALLOTMENT	5 minutes		
PERFORMANCE STANDARD	The learner demonstrates the proper way to pause, continue and full stop in reading and reciting the verse (Ayah)/chapter (surah) with proper Tajweed, clear voice in Tawasot and stage presence.		
21st Century Skills	Communication Literacy Global Awareness		
DESCRIPTION	This category will showcase the reading skills and developing good speech habits of Muslim learners. The Qur'an is the material to be used as it is an authentic source of stories and literature which is acceptable to all Muslims

I. Event Rules and Mechanics

I. Mechanics

A. Each division will have one (1) participant in the Qur'an Reading category as a skill exhibition. The participants may either be male or female ALTVE learners, ages 9-12 years old.

B. The participant shall read the selected Suwar/Surah in Tarteel assigned to the division:

- C. The participant should have a copy of the Holy Qur'an for reading.
- D. The participant should wear proper attire (black abaya and white hijab/kombong for female and white tawb/kimon with taqiyah/totob/kopya for male).
- E. The participant shall be seated on the floor with book stand and using a microphone in the actual reading of the selected Surah.
- F. Reading of the selected Surah shall be done within five (5) minutes.
- G. Certificates of Recognition will be awarded to all the participants and coaches.

I. Event Rules and Mechanics

- a. There shall be one (1) participant, ages six to nine (6-9) years old from any level and only Muslim male learners are qualified to perform this Adhan.
- b. The participant performs the Adhan in a maximum of five (5) minutes including the preparation. Zero point five (0.5) will be deducted from the total score if time exceeds.

I. Event Rules and Mechanics

- The competition is open to all ALS JHS and SHS learners.
- c. The participants must exhibit digital literacy/skills in a cheerful, lively and creative manner through Tech-Tok video in not more than 1 minute.
- The Tech-Tok video must have a hashtag #ALLinLahatSaALS in uploading the video entry.
- e. All contents and audio in the Tech-Tok must be original and are owned by the participant/s. All creative visual tools such as animations, simulations, physical demonstrations, or visual aids are allowed. The contestant will be held accountable to any issues that may arise with regards to the originality and accuracy of the content.
- f. The recommended Tech-Tok video format are the following:

 File size: The video should be up to 287.6 MB in size for iOS, or 72MB on android.

 Orientation: Tech-Tok is formatted to be viewed on a smartphone, so vertical video is the best.

Dimension: Tech-Tok video dimensions should be 1080x 1920

Aspect ratio: The aspect ration should be that of a standard smartphone screen,
9:16, 1:1 is also possible, but will not take up the whole screen

File Type: Tech-Tok supports mp4 and mov files.

g. The Tech-Tok video will be evaluated according to the following criteria mentioned above.
