

SUBJECT : REITERATION OF ADJUSTMENTS TO LEARNING
DELIVERY DUE TO SUSPENSIONS/CANCELLATIONS OF
CLASSES AS PROVIDED IN DEPED ORDER NO. 37, S. 2022

DATE : April 25, 2023

1. In connection with the memorandum released by OASOPS No. 2023-077 last April 20, 2023, wherein the well-being of the learners affected by extreme climate conditions as they attend in-person classes were considered, the Office reiterates DepEd Order No. 37, s. 2022, titled "Guidelines on the Cancellation or Suspension of Classes and Work in Schools in the Event of Natural Disasters, Power Outages/Power Interruptions, and Other Calamities." DO 037 s. 2022 provides for the implementation of modular distance learning in the event of cancelled or suspended classes due to natural disasters, calamities, and human-induced hazards to ensure learning continuity and the learning competencies and objectives are met.
2. In addition and in relation to the announcement of the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) last March 21, 2023, which marked the beginning of the warm and dry season in which warmer temperatures are expected, the Office reminds School Heads of their authority and responsibility, consistent with Rule VI, Section 6.1 of DepEd Order No. 01, s. 2003 or the *Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9155*, to suspend in-person classes and implement modular distance learning in cases of unfavorable weather and environment such as, but not limited to, extremely high temperatures which may considerably affect the conduct of classroom learning and put the learners'

3. The school heads shall inform the Office of the Schools Division Superintendent through the Public Schools District Supervisor (PSDS-CID) and Division Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officer (DRRM-SGOD) regarding the cancellation / suspension of in-person classes. They shall submit the proposed work arrangement of the personnel and the alternative delivery mode the school will adapt to the Office of the Assistant Schools Division Superintendent.
4. The school heads are responsible in the monitoring of the daily accomplishments of the personnel and the implementation of the alternative delivery mode.
