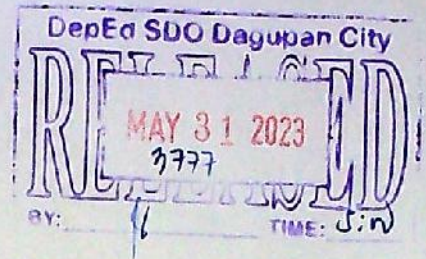

SUBJECT: **MANLINGKOR YA KALANGWERAN 2023**

1. The City of Dagupan is celebrating its 76th Founding Anniversary this year.
