

1. The Schools Division Office (SDO) of Dagupan City through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) shall conduct the 2023 Division Musabaqah Skills Exhibition on June 24, 2023 at 8:00 o'clock in the morning onwards at Ali' Vai Resort, Banaoang Calsiao, Dagupan City.
2. The Musabaqah Skills Exhibition aims to provide Arabic Language and Islamic Values Education (ALIVE) learners with opportunities to showcase their skills and talents through the exhibition of their performance.
3. The exhibition is composed of the following :
  - a. Harf touch
  - b. Call to Prayer
  - c. Islamic Values Education Quiz Bee
  - d. Qu'ran Reading
4. Attached are the Specific Guidelines of Each Event Skills Exhibition and List of Technical Working Group for reference. The members of the TWG shall meet on June 16, 2023 @ 3:00 o'clock in the afternoon at the Division Training Center.
5. Participation of the CID officials, school heads, and teachers of the implementing schools is enjoined.
6. Since the conduct of the activity is on a Saturday, officials and non-teaching personnel involved in the activity shall be given a Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) while teachers are entitled of a service credit, provided they will not exceed the 15-day allowable grant in a year.



7. All expenses relative to the conduct of the activity including supplies and materials, meals, token for the judges and other incidental expenses shall be charged against the Program Support Fund (PSF) or to the Muslim Education Program (MEP), subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

### ISLAMIC VALUES EDUCATION QUIZ BEE

Islamic Values Education Quiz Bee shall test the knowledge and understanding of the learners on the cultures, traditions, practices and beliefs that promote peace by answering questions derived from the Islamic Values Education subject.

#### Event Rules and Mechanics

1. There shall be one participant (male or female) aged seven to twelve years old for every ALIVE-Implementing school.
2. The officials for this category are the quizmaster, proctors, timekeeper, and recorder.
3. There shall be three (3) rounds of questions namely easy, average, and difficult.

LEVEL	NO. OF QUESTIONS	POINTS PER QUESTION	TOTAL
Easy	10	1	10
Average	5	2	10
Difficult	5	3	15

4. All coaches shall prepare questions in the easy (10), average (5), and difficult (5) rounds. All questions should be multiple-choice with four (4) options. All coaches shall drop their questions 15 minutes before the contest proper in the proper boxes.
5. Each question shall be read twice by the quizmaster. After the second reading, the quizmaster shall say "Go". The timer starts when the quizmaster gives the go signal. The contestants shall write their answers in the white board within 20 seconds.
6. When the is up, the timekeeper rings the bell/buzzer. The contestants then shall stop writing and show their answer to the proctor by raising their white board.
7. The judges shall check the answer of each contestant and the recorder shall record it on the tally board and tally sheet.
8. After each round, points shall be tabulated. The final scores shall be tabulated after the difficult round and shall be posted on the tally board.
9. The contestants with the highest points win. They shall be declared as first, second and third winners respectively.
10. In case of a tie, a clincher round shall be given. The first one to give the correct answer shall be the winner. If no contestant is able to give the correct answer, another clincher question shall be given until there is a winner.
11. The decision of the judges is final.

**QU'RAN READING**

Qu'ran Reading is an NFOT event category of Musabaqah that allows learner participants to showcase their reading skills while developing their good speech habits. The Qu'ran is the material to be used as it is an authentic source of stories and literature for Muslims.

**Event Rules and Mechanics**

1. Each school shall have one (1) participant in the Qu'ran Reading category as skills exhibition. The participant may either be male or female ALIVE learner aged 7-12 years old.
2. Participants shall have a copy of the Holy Qu'ran for reading.
3. Participants shall wear proper attire (black, abaya, and white hijab/kombong for female and white tawb/kimon with taqiyah/ totob/ kopya for male).
4. Participants shall be seated on the floor with book stand and using a microphone in the actual reading of the selected Surah.
5. Reading of the selected Surah shall be done within five (5) minutes.
6. The decision of the judges is final.

**CRITERIA FOR JUDGING**

<b>CRITERIA</b>	<b>PERCENTAGE</b>
Tajweed/Pronunciation - Read the assigned Surah with perfect and accurate pronunciation	40%
Tawasot/Chant - Read the assigned Surah with perfect and accurate words.	30%
Sawt/Voice Clarity - Read the assigned Surah with clear and loud voice.	20%
Hay'ah/Stage Presence - Read the assigned Surah with proper attire, proper placement of hands and confidence.	10%

### **HARF TOUCH**

**Harf Touch** is a skills exhibition wherein blindfolded learners touch the surface of the illustration board having an engraved Arabic letter being taught to the learners.

#### **Event Rules and Mechanics**

1. There shall be one (1) participant for every ALIVE-implementing school aged 6-8 years old, either male or female.
2. During the contest proper, the participants shall be seated at the designated holding area. They should not see the process undergone by the contestant on stage.
3. The participants take turns on stage to identify the letters engraved/cut on illustration board within one minute. The facilitator mixes the 28 letters as they take their turns.
4. There shall be one (1) timekeeper, one (1) recorder/tabulator, and three (3) panel of judges.
5. Timekeeper will signal the start and the end of time allotted for each contestant. The recorder/tabulator tallies the scores. One (1) point will be given to every correct answer.
6. Panel of judges shall confirm the number of correct responses.
7. The three (3) participants with the highest number of correct answers in a shortest recorded time shall be declared as the winner. There will be 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> winners. In case of a tie, another three (3) letters shall be added to the twenty-eight (28) letters for the clincher round to be given by the board of judges to determine the place/rank from which they tied.

**CALL TO PRAYER (ADZAN)**

**ADZAN** is an act of calling the Muslim (Islam believers) to perform a Salah (Prayer).

**Event Rules and Mechanics**

1. There shall be one (1) contestant per Alive-Implementing school aged 6-12 years old, male only.
2. The participant performs the Adzan verbally in a maximum of five minutes (5) including the preparation. Zero point five (0.5) will be deducted from the total score if time exceeds.
3. The proctor/facilitator shall say "Ibda" (start) , then, the participant begins to perform the adzan and may opt to stop when the bell/buzzer rings.
4. There shall be one (1) timekeeper, one (1) recorder/tabulator, and three (3) panel of judges.
5. There shall be 3 winners ; 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. The decision of the judges is final.

**CRITERIA FOR JUDGING**

CRITERIA	PERCENTAGE
Pronunciation - Performed the Adzan with perfect and accurate pronunciation.	35%
Mastery - Performed the Adzan with perfect and accurate words.	20%
Voice Clarity/Enunciation - Performed the Adzan with clear and loud voice.	35%
Stage Presence - Performed the Adzan with proper attire, proper placement of hands and confidence.	10%
