1st ILOCOS REGION ROVERMOOT

- 1. We are pleased to announce the conduct of the  $1^{\rm st}$  Ilocos Region Rover Moot to be held in the Municipality of Bautista, Pangasinan on 15-20 August 2023 with the theme "Sustaining Growth".
- 2. The Rover Moot aims every participants to:
  - 2.1 actively participate in the development of communities through the immersion program, activities and service projects like repainting of classrooms, construction of plant box, construction of signage and comfort rooms, school landscaping and tree planting programs;
  - 2.2 develop teamwork, sustain cooperative learning, and strengthen camaraderie and fellowship with Rover Scouts from other Councils:
  - 2.3 undertake the in-camp activities such as high-ropes, learn a trade, Scouts-Got Talent and Spiritual Development in order to develop life skills and 21st century leadership capacities
- 3. Qualification for Participation:
  - 3.1 **Rover Scouts** must be registered, sixteen to twenty four years of age (those that are in the Grade 11 and Grade 12) attended a Council/Regional/National Events, fit to undergo strenuous activities, have parents' permit and participated in a Rover Vigil.
  - Rover Leaders must have a Basic Training Course Graduate, with 2 years 3.2 serving as unit leader, physically fit as certified by a physician, with good moral character and registered Rover Leaders with Rover Scouts
- 4. Camp Registration. Registration Fee of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) shall be charge each participant to defray expenses for immersion projects, program materials, souvenir items and other administrative expenses. A Reservation Fee of Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00) shall be remitted to the Bank Account of the Eastern Pangasinan Council -BSP with Land Bank of the Philippines Account No. 000112-1173-18 on or before 4 August 2023 in order for the host council to establish the designated immersion site,

preparation of the souvenir items and other logistical requirements. The remaining three hundred pesos shall be paid upon arrival in the moot.

Reservation Fee shall be non-refundable but transferable. Attached herewith is the Roster of Participants which shall be forwarded to the Regional Office and Eastern Pangasinan Council with the scanned deposit slip.

5. Participation Quota. As agreed in our Goal Setting last February, herewith is the agreed participation Quota per Council appropriated from with the Senior Scout membership of December 2022. Councils may exceed their participation goal. Each local council is encourage to create a Contingent Management Team from their Rover Leaders.

6. Transportation & Food Provision.

Local Councils shall organize their transportation to and from the venue. They should organize their own Contingent Management Team. The farthest immersion site is about two kilometers from the town proper. Contingents are requested to have at least one vehicle staying for mobilization purposes.

- Other details of the Rover Moot such as Program of Activities, Roster of Participants will be issued immediately. Council Scout Executives and Council Program Commissioners will have their Ocular Inspection on 5 July 2023.
