Dear Madam,

Greetings from the Philippine Folk Dance Society (PFDS), the Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP), the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) and the PFDS Ilocos and Pangasinan chapters.

We would like to invite you and your MAPEH teachers to participate in the Regional Echo Seminar on Philippine Folkdances taught as Echo of the National Seminar in Bago City last July 26-30, 2023. This is going to be in Pangasinan on October 20-22, 2023.

This workshop will be conducted in partnership with the DepEd divisions in Region I in coordination with CCP, NCCA, DepEd, CHED, PASUS, Tesda, CSC, DILG, CCA, BCC and the PFDS-NOC.

#### The workshop aims to:

1. Develop knowledge, skills, understanding and appreciation for folk and traditional dances as bridges of cultures and people of the Philippines and Asia.

2. Upgrade competencies in teaching traditional Philippine dances among teachers, dance trainers,

choreographers, directors, dancers, and dance enthusiasts.

3. Provide teachers with resource materials on dance such as dance books, music CDs, videos, hand-outs, etc., and

4. Hold a forum to discuss significant issues and concerns of folk dancers, dance teachers, trainers, choreographers, and workers of the arts & culture councils.

Workshop activities include learning of published and unpublished dances, a Lecture-Demonstration, Forum, Street Dance, Cultural Shows, Regional/Provincial Presentations, Culminating Showcase by the participants, the General Assembly of members of the PFDS, and a Folk Dance Competition.

Invited to attend are teachers at all levels, dance trainers, teachers in charge of dance groups, dance directors, choreographers, teachers and students who are members of dance groups, cultural officers, and cultural events coordinators.

A One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P 1,500) registration shall be charged to cover workshop expenses including workshop materials - dance book and CD, supplies, and kits, honoraria for speakers, resource persons, staff, performing groups, and other incidental expenses.

Participants shall take care of arrangements for transportation, accommodations, and meals. Assistance shall be provided for accommodation requirements on a first served basis in selected schools, dormitories, hotels, and other lodging areas in the city, especially for participants coming from the provinces. Participants are encouraged to bring traditional regional costumes for the Regional Night presentation.



The workshop aims to develop knowledge, skills, understanding and appreciation for folk and traditional dances as bridges of cultures and people of the Philippines and Asia; upgrade competencies in teaching tradition Philippine dances among teachers, dance trainers, choreographers, directors, dancers, and dance enthusiasts; provide teachers with resource materials on dance such as dance books, music CDs, videos, hand-outs, etc.; and hold a forum to discuss significant issues and concerns of folk dancers, dance teachers, trainers, choreographers, and workers of the arts and culture councils.

This seminar-workshop is open to all MAPEH teachers in elementary, junior and senior high school both in public and private schools.

Participants will be charged a registration fee of Php 1,500.00 to cover the cost of producing the workshop kit (folk dance instruction, CD's, T-shirt, and certificates) trainer's accommodation, event venue rental, and other operating expenses.
