NUTRITIOUS FOOD PRODUCTS- MILK FEEDING COMPONENT 2023

## PARTICULARS

- Pursuant to Republic Act No. 11037 known as "Masustansyang Pagkain para sa 1. Batang Pilipino Act" and DepEd Order No. 31, s. 2021 entitled, "Guidelines on the Implementation of School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP)", this office shall implement the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) Nutritious Food Products - Milk Feeding Component targeting kinder to Grade 6 severely wasted (SW) and wasted (W) SBFP beneficiaries during FY 2023. Grade 6 are no longer included and shall be replaced by kinder entrants.
- 2. The School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) Nutritious food Products (92 Feeding days) to start this September 2023 and Milk Feeding Component (34 Feeding days) shall be implemented on October/November 2023 (Second Batch) to address the nutritional needs of the learners during the pandemic.
- The program primarily aims to support the SBFP by providing fresh milk and the ready-to-eat food packs as supplement given to underweight learners, develop milkdrinking habit among the beneficiaries, improve nutritional status and address undernutrition and hunger.









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- 4. The Schools Division Office, through Schools Governance Operations Division (SGOD) School Health Nutrition Unit (SHNU) shall endeavor to collaborate with the Philippine Carabao Center (PCC) Island Office for the delivery of fresh milk through a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) including services for production, quality assurance, processing, packaging, logistics and delivery of fresh milk.
- 5. Relative to this, all elementary schools shall ensure the readiness to receive, handle and store the NFP and fresh milk which are packed in food-grade polyethylene pouches. A given orientations/ informations to the SchoolHeads/Schools SBFP coordinators on the various details of implementation, the scheduled date including its mechanics of delivery and receipt by the schools, timelines, storage, handling, accounting, risks management, forms, reporting and recording system, duties and responsibilities, monitoring and evaluation, among others.
