



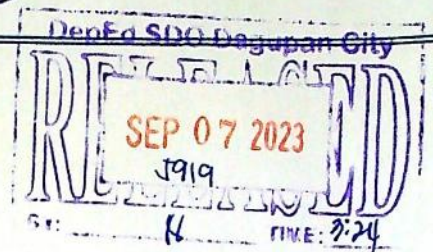




MEMORANDUM

Subject: **COMPLETION OF IMMERSION PROJECTS**

1. The Ilocos Region on 15-20 August 2023 through Eastern Pangasinan Council conducted the 1st Ilocos Region Rovermoot with seven immersion sites namely: Vacante Elementary School, Baluyot Elementary School and High School, Nibaliw Elementary School, Bautista Elementary School, Bautista National High School and Casa Hacienda.
2. Of the above stated immersion sites, four projects were not fully completed, thus we cannot submit the entire report of the immersion and rover moot until we have completed the projects especially the Casa Hacienda project which we need manpower for painting, varnishing and cleaning up of the grounds.
3. In order to complete the Hacienda Casa, we will be conducting second phase of community immersion projects which will provide opportunity to earn another quadrant for those who participated in the Rover Moot and for those who fail to attend due to another equally important event, and would like to earn the 1st Quadrant either done.
4. In line with this the following are the herein slated community service dates:

2 September 2023	0900-1600hrs
10 September 2023	0900 – 1600hrs
16 September 2023	0900 – 1600hrs
24 September 2023	0900 – 1600hrs
30 September 2023	0900 – 1600hrs
5. We will have a Special Court of Honor on 30th September 2023 for those who have completed the 5 immersion dates and conduct the ceremony for proper flag disposal because of the small flag that will be removed from Casa Hacienda.
6. If weather is not favorable for the listed activities at Casa Hacienda, we will cancel the activity for day, as we will always protect the safety and health of our participants. We will have the Court of Honor only after completion of the five immersion days.
7. All participants who wish to participate are encouraged to bring bolo or paint brush as we only have limited funds for the development of the Casa Hacienda. Please bring your packed lunch.
