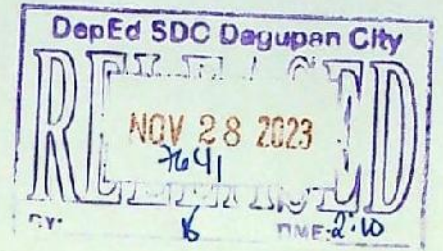

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

## IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES

### **PROJECT TITLE:**

**SPORTS SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT ENHANCEMENT DISTRIBUTION (SSEED)  
PROGRAM AT THE SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICES (SDOs)  
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023**

### **PROJECT DESCRIPTION /BACKGROUND:**

The Adoption of Basic Education Development Plan 2030 (BEDP 2030) also known as DepEd Order No. 24, s. 2022 highlighted Learners' Resiliency and Well-Being. It is one of the important pillars needed to prioritize seriously in course of implementing BEDP 2030. One of the strategies to achieving its intermediate outcome is to promote learner' physical and socio-emotional skills development. The developmental aspect of physical, socio-emotional, and mental health should be strengthened and enhanced for all individuals. Designing physical activities, competitions, and talent enhancement strategically and rationally in clubs/organizations as co-curricular and extra-curricular activities shall be done in the Department (p.158).

The Department of Education (DepEd) through Bureau of Learner Support Services - School Sports Division (BLSS-SSD) has developed already a Comprehensive School Sports Program (CSSP). It is a dynamic school sports program with strong objectives of strengthening sports at school levels. CSSP provides equal opportunity to all learners and teachers in promoting active lifestyle for fitness and long life. It also serves as an alternative avenue for the learners, teachers, coaches, and other stakeholders to be involved in sports and other recreational sports activities.

In this connection, Sports Supplies and Equipment Enhancement Distribution (SSEED) is a support program to CSSP and Sport Club Implementation in strengthening sports at school levels. It shall provide standard sports supplies, sports materials and sports equipment to every qualified recipient-school that will be used in their Sports Clubs and Physical Education (PE) classes. It will promote and intensify students' participation knowing sports essentials are ready and accessible.

In October 2022, BLSS-SSD released the first batch of support fund to at least 1241 expected recipient-schools through their respective SDOs. Fortunately, 1602 schools received the support fund and submitted their reports with positive feedback. Therefore, BLSS-SSD shall provide support fund for the second batch of recipient-schools in the implementation of SSEED Program FY 2023.



**SCOPE:**

The SSEED Program shall provide learners access to standard sports supplies and equipment in relation to the implementation and sustainability of Sports Club program.

**PROPOSED SCHEDULE/TIMELINE OF ACTIVITIES:**

The implementation of SSEED Program is on the last quarter of fiscal year (FY) 2023.

**TARGET RECIPIENTS:**

The recipient-schools shall be determined by the Schools Division Office based on the recommended list given by the BLSS-SSD. The criteria used for the recommended qualified recipients are the following:

- a. registered their existing Sports Club/s and found in the SSD Directory;
- b. accomplished and submitted sports club profile/registration forms (Form SSC.1 and Form SSC.2) signed by their concerned superior/s;
- c. with qualified personnel to handle the Sports Club;
- d. has available playing facilities such as covered court/multi-purpose hall, vacant space, open field for physical activities; and
- e. actively participates in any sports activities.

**SELECTION AND PRIORITIZATION OF RECIPIENT SCHOOLS:**

1. The constituted Committee by the School Division Office (SDO) in first batch that composed of a Committee Head (Division Sports Officer or duly designated coordinator/officer by the SDS) and two (2) members identified by the Committee Head is still in-charged on the selection of recipient-school based on the recommended list given by the BLSS-SSD.
2. The Committee shall consider carefully the allotted slots to the qualified SDOs in identifying recipient-schools for each Division.




3. The Schools Division Office shall:

- a. submit the list of select-recipient schools to the Central Office through Regional Sports Officers;
- b. ensure that the Schools Division Office sports program is aligned with their Regional Sports Development Program;
- c. provide technical assistance to schools in the implementation of FY 2023 SSEED Program and other sports program;
- d. submit the consolidated utilization and implementation reports to the Central Office through email at [blss.ssd@deped.gov.ph](mailto:blss.ssd@deped.gov.ph) duly signed by the Schools Division Superintendents and must copy furnish the Regional Office (Regional Sports Officers), a month after the implementation with a subject BATCH 2 SSEEDP Report(space)<Region>(space)<SDO Name>. For example, BATCH 2 SSEEDP Report NCR SDO PASAY.





3. Schools that were successful beneficiaries of the first batch of the SSEED Program are ineligible to be recipients of the Program for its succeeding batches.
4. The Committee may determine additional criteria for the selection of qualified-recipient schools if necessary.

**ALLOCATION OF FUND:**

1. The select recipient-school in the Province/City Division shall receive Fifty Thousand pesos (Php 50,000.00).
2. Each Regional Office and School Division Offices with qualified recipient-schools shall receive support fund to defray transportation and other expenses as part of their function in monitoring and ensuring the smooth implementation of the program (*see attached Allocation List*).
3. The program support fund shall be released directly to the respective Regional Offices and Schools Division Offices.
4. The list of sports supplies, equipment and materials with minimum technical specifications per sport event eligible for procurement are recommended. In case some items in the given list are already available in their respective Sports Clubs, other needed sports items could be procured.
5. All expenses shall be subject to the usual budgeting, accounting, auditing and procurement rules and regulations.

**ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**


1. The Central Office shall:
  - a. formulate guidelines on the implementation of the FY 2023 SSEED Program;
  - b. facilitate the downloading of financial assistance for the procurement of sports supplies and equipment; and
  - c. conduct the monitoring of procurement of sports supplies and materials/fund utilization of Schools Division Offices in coordination with the Regional Sports Officers and Division Sports Officers, as part of its mandated functions and responsibilities.
2. The Regional Office shall:
  - a. ensure that the Regional Sports Development Program is aligned with their Comprehensive Schools Sports Program;
  - b. provide technical assistance for School Division Offices in the implementation of sports programs;
  - c. monitor the implementation of FY 2023 SSEED Program; and



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
