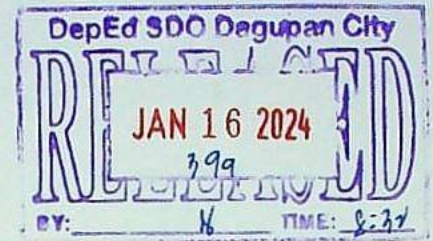

**ESSAY-WRITING (SECONDARY)**

**GUIDELINES/MECHANICS:**

1. There shall be sixteen (16) contestants for the Essay-writing Contest in the Secondary Level on Sustainable Development Goals. Eight (8) from Public Schools and Eight (8) from Private Schools and they must be certified Grade 7-10 learners from Dagupan City.
2. After the announcement of the central theme of the contest, participants are given one (1) hour finish their essay. The essay must be written in English with maximum of 1000 words excluding prepositions/conjunctions.
3. The contestants will be given numbers which they will write at the upper righthand corner of their entries.
4. The secretariat shall provide the writing materials. Only black or blue ballpen will be allowed.
5. The contest facilitator shall announce the following during the contest time: last thirty minutes, last fifteen minutes, last five minutes and last one minute.
6. After the contest work period, all entries will be submitted to the contest facilitator.
7. Panel of judges shall be composed of one chairperson and at least two members.
8. After the adjudication and tabulation of results, the Panel of Judges shall announce and award the winners of the contest. The decision of the Panel of Judges shall be final and non-appealable.
9. Top three (3) winners will receive cash prizes and Certificate of Recognition.

**QUIZ BEE ON SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS**

**GUIDELINES/MECHANICS:**

- There shall be 16 groups (8 public and 8 private) schools of SDO, Dagupan City for the Quiz Bee on Sustainable Development Goals. Each group will consist of 3 participants.
- Eligible participants in each group are those enrolled in Grade 7 or Grade 8 only.
- There shall be a total of 30 questions (10 easy, 10 average, and 10 difficult questions) to be asked. The Clincher questions will only take place if there is a tie.
- Each Easy question will be given 1 point, 2 points for Average and 3 points for Difficult questions. In the Clincher round, as many questions will be asked until winner emerges.
- There shall be a Quizmaster to facilitate the contest. Questions will be asked twice and participants can only start writing their answers after the question was read for the second time.
- Each group participants will be given 10 seconds to answer Easy questions, 15 seconds for Average questions, 20 seconds for Difficult questions and 30 seconds for Clincher questions.
- Each group participants will be asked to raise their boards to check their answers which will be validated by the assigned proctors and properly recorded afterwards.
- Validation of answers shall be primarily based on the official answers as stated in the official quiz document. All answers are final and unappealable. Should there be any protest only the official coach shall raise the question right after the verification. No other protest shall be entertain after the question at hand.
- The coverage of the quiz bee includes concepts, theories and other information from the Sustainable Development Goals.
- Each participating school shall submit 5 questions for each round following the format below an hour before the scheduled time of the quiz bee.
  - 1/4 size of an A4 bond paper (length wise), Bookman Old Style Font 11 with reference source of question-and-answer key.
  - These questions shall be randomly picked during the quiz bee proper.





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- Winners shall be determined based on the total accumulated points from the different categories.
- Each group participants should be at the venue 1 hour before the contest to submit fully accomplished entry forms, test questions and for a short orientation.
- The top three (3) winners will receive cash prizes and Certificate of Recognition. The none winners will receive Certificate of Participation.

**SPELLING BEE (Grade 4 & 7)**

**Guidelines and Mechanics:**

1. Participants to the Spelling Bee are Grade Four and Grade 7 learners of Dagupan City. There shall be eight (8) participants from public schools and eight (8) participants from private schools.
2. Contestants shall be provided with a pen, a writing board and an eraser for them to use during the contest.
3. There shall be a total of twenty-five ( 25) English spelling words to be given, 10 for Easy round, 10 for Average round, and 5 for Difficult round. Spelling words should be in the Grade Four level and Grade 7 level.
4. Points for every correct answer shall be given as follows:
  - ❖ 1 point - Easy round
  - ❖ 2 points - Average round
  - ❖ 3 points - Difficult round
5. Each participating school shall submit three (3) spelling words in English for each round (Easy, Average, Difficult and Clincher) following the format below **(1) ONE HOUR** before the scheduled time of the spelling bee. Submit entry forms to the contest facilitator.  
¼ size of an A4 bond paper (length wise), Century Gothic Style Font 12.

**Please follow the given format below:**

**de·vel·op·ment ( noun)**

Meaning: The process of developing or being developed.

Sentence: The architect traces the development of the house.

**(Type the word, part of speech, pronunciation, and use the word in a sentence).**

6. The Spelling Master shall read the word twice, use the word in a sentence and read the word again.  
After reading the word again, the Spelling Master shall say "Go" – only then will the contestants be allowed to write the word. Countdown shall start after the Spelling Master says the word "Go".
7. Contestants shall write the word within one (1) minute.
8. Proctors shall check the answers after each word given.
9. Should a contestant wish to change an answer that he/she has written down, this answer should be crossed out with 1 horizontal line or totally erase the word, and the new answer should be written clearly. A contestant is allowed to change his/her answer within the time allotted for a particular word.
10. No parent, trainer, coach or any unauthorized person shall be allowed to stay within 5-meter radius from the contest area once the contest has started.
11. Results of every round (Easy, Average and Difficult) shall be added to determine the winner. In case of a tie, the tie-breaker word shall be taken from the clincher category. The first contestant to get the right answer shall be declared winner.
12. Only the contestant can raise a complaint/clarification, and do so before the next word/item is read. Each complaint/clarification will be decided upon by the board of judges. The decision of the board of judges is FINAL.
13. The top three (3) winners will receive cash prizes and Certificate of Recognition. The none winners will receive Certificate of Participation.

**HIP HOP DANCE COMPETITION (ELEMENTARY LEVEL)**  
**CONTEST GUIDELINES, MECHANICS, AND CRITERIA FOR JUDGING**

**A. Contest Guidelines**

1. This competition is open to Public (8 groups) and Private Schools (8 groups) composed of 10-15 members of SDO Dagupan City.
2. All members of the crew should submit the following:
  - a. Certificate of enrolment duly signed by the School Principal/Registrar
  - b. Checklist of Requirements & Entry Form
  - c. Waiver/Parents' Consent
  - d. Competition Music
3. Participants should be at the venue 30 minutes before the contest for drawing of lots.
4. Participants will be given opportunity to block their routine on stage before the day of the competition at CSI Atrium. Those who are absent/late for their designated blocking time will not be allowed to block on stage at a later time. Entry forms will be submitted to the contest facilitator.
5. A panel of judges shall determine the winners based on the given criteria. Any violation of the foregoing rules may cause 1point deduction per violation on the final score. The decision of the panel shall be final and irrevocable.
6. The order of performance shall be determined by the management via drawing of lots before the competition starts.
7. The top three (3) winners will receive cash prizes and Certificate of Recognition. The none winners will receive Certificate of Participation.

## **B. Contest Mechanics**

### **1. Performance & Stage Rules**

- a. The duration of the dance should be a minimum of 3 minutes, and a maximum of 5 minutes. Deduction of one (1) point from the total score for every excess of thirty (30) seconds shall be applied.
- b. Any kind of hip hop dance is allowed (locking, popping, krumping, house, stepping, breakdance, whacking, tutting, voguing, party dances, hip hop choreography) or any kind of dance with hip hop as their focal thought of choreography.
- c. No vulgarity, obscenity, and explicit contents are allowed.
- d. Pyrotechnics or dangerous stunts are not allowed.

### **2. Costumes and Props**

- a. Costumes must be decent.
- b. All costume malfunction making team members being exposed are grounds for deductions. Please make sure to have dress rehearsals prior to competition to avoid any costume problems.
- c. Props that are not considered as an integral part of a crew's attire are prohibited (ex. canes, chairs, tambourines, musical instruments).
- d. Attire may include accessories such as hats, scarves, caps, gloves, jewelries, etc. Removing pieces of clothing during the performance is permitted provided it is not offensive or out of character.

### **3. Music Requirements**

- a. The music used in the routine must be from three (3) to five (5) minutes.
- b. Participants' competition music must be submitted through email at [josetaparo001@deped.gov.ph](mailto:josetaparo001@deped.gov.ph) on or before the said event. Please follow the format below in the submission of the soft copies of your group music.

File Format: **School Name\_Group Name**

Example: **BLISS ES\_BTS**

- c. There is no maximum or minimum number of songs/recordings that may be used in the routine and it may be edited to enhance choreography and personal performance.
- d. The competition music must not contain inappropriate, lewd, or offensive language.

### **4. Inevitable Circumstances**

- a. These are occurrences beyond the control of the crew that affect their ability to perform at the beginning or any time in a routine. An extraordinary circumstance is not limited to the following:
  - (1) Incorrect music is played or cued,
  - (2) Music problems due to equipment malfunction,
  - (3) Disturbances caused by general equipment failure.
- b. In case the routine is stopped by an extraordinary circumstance, the management and/or judges will review the situation, and upon confirming a decision and correcting the problem, the crew will be re-introduced, and will be allowed to re-start their routine.

**5. Medical Attention and Condition**

- a. Participants who are experiencing bad health conditions such as cough, runny nose, fever and flu, skin rashes are not allowed to join the competition in compliance to the minimum health and safety protocols.
- b. In cases of injuries or serious disabilities, it is the responsibility of the group members, manager, or choreographer to report a group member's injury to the management.
- c. If at any time, prior to or during competition, a group member becomes ill, or his/her physical or emotional condition is at risk by participating, he/she may be declared ineligible to compete, and may be disqualified from the competition. The management reserves the right to prohibit any competitor who appears to have such serious disability or injury or needs medical attention.

### **QUIZ BEE-Group of 3 (GRADE 6)**

#### **Guidelines and Mechanics:**

1. This quiz bee is intended for Grade 6 learners in SDO-Dagupan City. There shall be eight (8) groups, 4 groups from public elementary schools and 4 groups from private schools. Each group will consist of 3 participants coming from different schools within the District/Private Schools.
2. The coverage of the quiz bee includes concepts, theories and other information from the Sustainable Development (SDG) Goals.
3. There will be four (4) rounds of different categories (Easy, Average, Difficult and Clincher). The Clincher round will only take place if there is a tie.
4. EASY round will have ten (10) questions-Multiple Choice, AVERAGE round will have ten (10) questions and DIFFICULT round will have ten (10) questions. In the CLINCHER round, as many questions will be asked until winner emerges. Each round shall have a corresponding point for every correct answer as follows:
  - EASY- 1 point each
  - AVERAGE - 2 points each
  - DIFFICULT - 3 points
  - CLINCHER - 4 points
5. A question's time limit shall depend on its difficulty level.
  - EASY ROUND- 10 seconds
