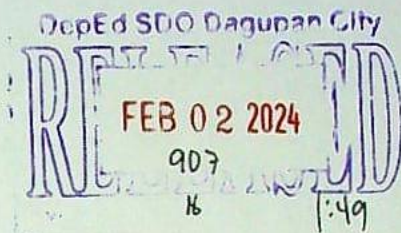



**SCHOOL-BASED ACTIVITIES FOR THE NATIONAL ARTS MONTH 2024**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 683, s. 1991 declaring the month of February as National Arts Month, the Department of Education Regional Office I through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) encourages all public and private elementary and secondary schools to conduct School-based Activities for the National Arts Month 2024 from February 1 – 29 anchored on the theme: *Ani ng Sining, Bayang Malikhain*.
2. The month long activities aim to:
  - a. develop students' and teachers' artistic capabilities;
  - b. provide learners and teachers the avenue to showcase their artistic skills in different ways of an art form; and
  - c. demonstrate appreciation of the culture and arts of their localities through different activities.
3. The following are suggested activities to be conducted in the school level:

Sining-Paglalahad	Immerse in a visual feast as learners unleash their artistic expressions in a month-long exhibit. Tik Tok Challenge	Let learners participate in a Tik Tok Challenge that goes beyond the ordinary, incorporating the theme: <i>"Ani ng Sining, Bayang Malikhain."</i> Groove and move as learners showcase their dance prowess.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide the theme: <i>"Ani ng Sining, Bayang Malikhain."</i></li> <li>• Conduct workshops or tutorials for dance techniques and Tik Tok choreography.</li> <li>• Set a timeline for participants to create and submit their Tik Tok dance entries.</li> <li>• Host a live or virtual event to showcase the dance</li> </ul>

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


Sinema-Presentasyon	Experience the magic of short films created by our talented learners. Dive into stories that depict the dynamic role of the youth in nation-building, presented through impressive editing and filmmaking skills.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Call for short film submissions with a focus on the youth's role in nation-building.</li> <li>• Provide resources or workshops on film editing and storytelling. Establish a submission deadline.</li> <li>• Host a film screening event (live or virtual) to showcase the films, followed by discussions and recognition of outstanding entries.</li> </ul>

PROCLAMATION NO. 683

DECLARING THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY OF EVERY YEAR AS NATIONAL ARTS MONTH

WHEREAS, Article XIV, Section 15, of the Constitution states that: "Arts and letters shall enjoy the patronage of the State. The State shall conserve, promote, and popularize the nation's historical and cultural heritage and resources, as well as artistic creations";

WHEREAS, the disciplines of theatre, dance, music, visual arts, architecture, literature, media arts, and film need to be preserved, enriched, and evolved in a climate of free artistic and intellectual expression;

WHEREAS, the Philippines joins the rest of the world in celebrating the International Decade of Culture, and has declared the Decade 1988 to 1998 as Decade of Filipino Culture and Nationalism;

WHEREAS, the month of February is now well remembered in the hearts and minds of our people and the peoples of other nations as a time for nationalism and pride in being Filipino;



NOW, THEREFORE, I, CORAZON C. AQUINO, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare the month of February of every year as National Arts Month.

~~All agencies of the government are hereby enjoined to undertake activities in accordance with the spirit of this proclamation.~~ The Department of Education, Culture and Sports, in cooperation with the Presidential Commission on Culture and Arts, the Cultural Center of the Philippines, and other cultural agencies, is hereby tasked to be the lead agency in carrying out such activities.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 28th day of January in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and ninety one.
