

The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), will celebrate the 20th National Dental Health Month in February 2024 with the theme "Celebrating Decades of Healthy Smiles". This is pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 559 dated February 24, 2004.

The celebration aims to:

- a) To promote oral health awareness and education nationwide and
- b) Promote good oral hygiene habits.

The month-long celebration should launch fun-filled activities that will increase oral health awareness among the learners and the school populace as well. The following are the suggested activities:

First Week	Oral Health Awareness Campaigns: Initiate school-wide campaign to raise awareness about oral health Use bulletin boards, newsletters, and social media platforms to share oral health tips, facts, and resources. Attend National toothbrushing day "Sang Milyong Sipilyo Sabayang Pagsisipilyo."
Second Week	Oral Health Workshops and Seminars: Classroom activities (lectures/Oral health education) Social media campaign

	 School community oral health awareness through orientation, lectures and activities involving parents, teaching and non-teaching staff
Third Week	Delivery of Dental services Collaborate with local dental clinics or practitioners to organize on-site dental check-ups for students. Provide information to parents about the importance of regular dental check-ups.
Fourth Week	Interactive Workshops: Set up interactive workshops that include hands-on activities. Have demonstrations on proper brushing techniques and provide students with toothbrushes and dental floss to practice.

DepEd school dentists are advised to coordinate with the Philippine Dental Association (PDA) local chapters and other stakeholders on the activities scheduled during the month – long celebration. Dentists and other school health personnel in the regions and school's divisions shall take the lead in the celebration.
