Subsequent to series of inspections and considerations to several prospective sites of the 59th Senior/Cadet and 47th Junior Regional Camps, we have finally decided to conduct the simultaneous Camps at Clarkzilla Mango Camp, Clark, Pampanga on April 6-9, 2024. Initial details, as follows:

CAMP FEE: PhP3,400.00 (for both girls and adults)- to cover campsite fee, camp souvenirs, certificate, badges, program materials, insurance and program offerings of Clarkzilla Camp, as follows:

PARTICIPANTS : - at least 2 patrols per level per Council (8girls:1 Adult Leader)

CAMPER'S QUALIFICATIONS:

Girls:

1. Must be a registered Girl Scout and must present her GSP ID upon registration.
2. Must have at least attended a Troop/District/Provincial Camp.
3. Must have earned badges in the 8-Point Challenge.
4. Must be able to live by the GS Promise and Law.
5. Must be emotionally stable and physically fit with Medical Certificate.
6. Must have attended a Patrol Leaders Training Course (for Senior/cadet GS)

Adults:

1. Must be a duly registered Troop Leader and must present her GSP ID upon registration.
2. She must have directed or served as a staff in troop/district/Provincial camps.
3. She must be able to live by the GS Promise and Law.
4. She must be emotionally stable and physically fit with Medical Certificate.
5. She must be a Campcraft/Camper Permit/Cam

***Campers and Adult Leaders are required to wear Camp IDs at all times.**


