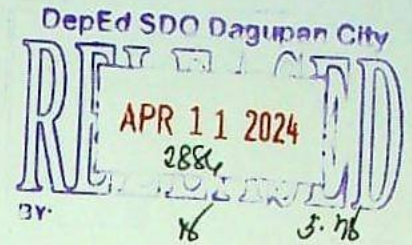



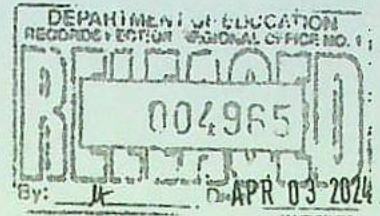

To: Schools Division Superintendents



2. The training aims to equip the Gender and Development (GAD) coordinators with the knowledge and skills in creating and implementing effective programs, activities, and projects (PAPs) that ensure a safe, supportive, and motivating environment for learners in the school and in their community.
