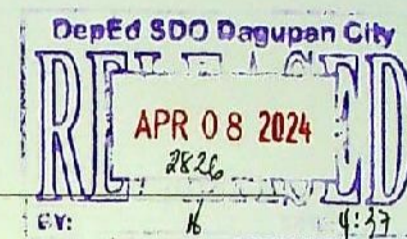






SUBJECT : TURN-OVER OF SAFETY AND EMERGENCY SUPPLIES AND
 EQUIPMENT FOR TWENTY-TWO (22) BENEFICIARY SCHOOLS

DATE : April 4, 2024

- The FY 2023 Disaster Preparedness and Response Programs (DPRP) funds are intended for Implementing Units (IUs) to implement and monitor Disaster Preparedness-related PPAs and Response Interventions under the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS). The Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS) provides safety and emergency supplies and equipment to pre-identified One Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty-Eight (1,988) schools listed in **Enclosure 8: List of School Beneficiaries of the Safety and Emergency Supplies and Equipment**, based on a Memorandum from OUOPS No. 2023-04, released on July 25, 2023: Guidelines on the Utilization and Reporting of the FY 2023 Disaster Preparedness and Response Program (DPRP) Funds. Twenty-two (22) public elementary and secondary schools were among the included in the Schools Division Office of Dagupan City. The prioritization and selection of the 1,988 schools was based on the following criteria:
 - Schools with critical hazard exposure and vulnerability recorded for the last twelve (12) years based on the analysis of the consolidated hazard exposure data from Enhanced Basic Education Information Systems (EBEIS) SY 2009-2010 through SY 2020-2021; and
 - Available funds from DepEd DRRMS for this activity.
- The downloaded funds were utilized for the procurement of safety and emergency supplies and equipment will be turned over to the School Heads of the twenty-two (22) identified schools on **April 12, 2024** at 10:00 a.m. at the Division Training Center (DTC).
