

The Nationwide Qualifying Examination is for students who are willing to pursue a how-year BS Fisheries Course starting 1st Semester of SY 2025-2029 (August 2025). Central Euzon State University (CLSU)-Manov, Naeva Ecija; University of the Philippines Visavas (UPV)-Miagao, floilo: Cagoyan State University (CSU)-Aparri, Cagayan; Pangasinan State University-Butmaley Campus (PSG-BC), Burmaley, Pangasinan; Don Mariano Marcos Memorial State University-College of Fisheries (DMMMSU-CF). Ubagan, Stu. Tomas, La Umon, Ilocus Sur Polytechnic State College-Narvacan Campus (ISPSC-NC), Narvacan, Hocos Sur and Mariano Marcos State University (MMSU), Pias Sur, Curriniao, Ilocos Norte.





- For high school graduate applicants who completed their high school under the old curriculum, the general weighted average (GWA) shall not be lower than 80%;
- For Senior High School students under K12 curriculum, graduating students GWA of the last 3 immediate preceding semesters of his Senior High School in any Track shall not be lower than 80% or its equivalent
- 6. Of good moral character as certified by the School Head/Principal;


