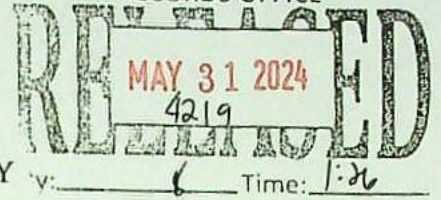




The Nationwide Qualifying Examination is for students who are willing to pursue a four-year BS **Fisheries Course** starting 1st Semester of SY 2025-2029 (August 2025). Qualifiers will be required to pass the entrance examination and enroll in any of the following State Universities and Colleges (SUCs): Central Luzon State University (CLSU)-Maunabo, Nueva Ecija; University of the Philippines Visayas (UPV)-Miagao, Iloilo; Cagayan State University (CSU)-Aparri, Cagayan; Pangasinan State University-Bumaleay Campus (PSU-BC), Bumaleay, Pangasinan; Don Mariano Marcos Memorial State University-College of Fisheries (DMMMSU-CF), Ubagan, Sta. Tomas, La Union; Ilocos Sur Polytechnic State College-Narvacan Campus (ISPSC-NC), Narvacan, Ilocos Sur and Mariano Marcos State University (MMSU), Pias Sur, Currimao, Ilocos Norte.

1. Must be a natural-born Filipino citizen;
2. Any Senior high school graduate or graduating student whose parent(s) or guardian is a Registered Fisherfolk (Fish-R/Mangingisdang Juan);
3. Not more than 25 years old at the time of the examination, who has not earned any units in college
4. For high school graduate applicants who completed their high school under the old curriculum, the general weighted average (GWA) shall not be lower than 80%;
5. For Senior High School students under K12 curriculum, graduating students GWA of the last 3 immediate preceding semesters of his Senior High School in any Track shall not be lower than 80% or its equivalent
6. Of good moral character as certified by the School Head/Principal;
7. Parent(s)/guardian or the applicant must be physically residing in the municipality of the Region for at least six (6) months, where the slot of the scholarship program is allotted;
8. Parent(s)/guardian must be registered municipal fisherfolk duly certified by the Municipal Agricultural Officer (MAO) or the BFAR Regional Office in his/her area.

3. Senior High School graduates or graduating student who is a member of an Indigenous Culture Community/ Indigenous People (ICC/IC) recognized by INCIP and willing to pursue four-year course on Fisheries and Aquatic Science Starting 1st Semester of SY 2024-2025





INDIGENOUS CULTURAL COMMUNITIES/ INDIGENOUS PEOPLE (ICCs / IPs)

- Must be a natural-born Filipino Citizen;
- Any highschool graduate or senior high school graduating student whose member of an Indigenous Cultural Community/ Indigenous People (ICCs/IPs) recognized by NCIP;
- Not more than 25 years old at the time of the examination, who has not earned any units in college.
- Students who have earned units in college may also apply;
- For senior students under K12 curriculum, graduating students GWA of the last 3 immediate preceding semesters of his Senior High School in any Track shall not be lower than 75%

All qualified applicants should file their applications on or before **August 15, 2024** with complete documentary requirements attached to their respective LGU's, BFAR Provincial Offices / Technological Stations and/or BFAR Regional Field Office 1.
