

Shows consistent dedication and engagement in organizational activities, displaying a willingness to take on tasks and support team objectives. 	 Holds a defined position within the organization and demonstrates effective collaboration with peers while fulfilling responsibilities associated with the role. Exhibits proactive initiative and takes on leadership roles within student and/or youth organizations, actively engaging other team members and contributing to the organization's goals. 	 Takes on key leadership roles such as President, Chairman, Governor, or similar positions in student organizations, demonstrating proactive initiative, responsibility, and effective leadership. Fosters collaborative relationships within the team, creating a supportive environment. Exhibits outstanding conflict resolution skills to maintain harmony and productivity within the organization.
Contribution to the School and/or Community (30%)	Actively participates in extra-curricular school activities and/or engages in socio-community work, demonstrating involvement and commitment to both school and community initiatives. - Schools are required to submit the evaluation of nominated students as evidence of meeting this
 criterion.
- The evaluation form must be signed by the Selection Committee established by the school.
