



#### CONTINGENCY PLAN

- All teacher participants to this training are fully vaccinated and must present parental consent fully signed and dated over printed name.
- All delegates must be subjected to triage and will undergo necessary temperature check and present evidence of no comorbidity or signs of diseases.
- Delegates must bring their own medicine and other necessities for the 3 day regional skills training - academic / non academic quest and demonstration.
- Delegates will be classified into Group A and Group B and will be assigned to their respective training venue. Class A ( JDV Hall ) and Group B ( Conference Room ) .
- During training session and academic quests, participants will be monitored properly based on planned route and venue.
- Facilities of Asian Fisheries Academy are disinfected and have a free access to good air and sufficient water supply. Ensure that the occupants are in normal capacity.
- Security guards are in full force so as to ensure protection and safety of all teachers,
   staff and student delegates of the 3 day regional event.
- 8. There will be an access to medical team within the training area.
- 9. Food shall be served in an open area where delegates must observe social distancing
- 10. Delegates are not allowed to go out of the center especially at night except for emergency reason however the latter shall be accompanied by an adult (parent / guardian / teacher). In the first place, observance of curfew is embedded in the house rules.





### **Guidelines for Demonstration Teaching**

- 1.Demonstration teaching must be within a minimum of 40 minutes and maximum of 60 minutes in a synchronous manner.
- 2.Demonstration teacher using video lesson must be in operation; Video lesson can be used as strategy not a sole demonstration teaching learning process.
- 3. Peer teaching is allowed for synchronous teaching. For an on line / google classroom. . . . demonstration teacher will source for connections. Gadgets and connections available during the training period and are available in the training venue could be utilized .
- 4. Three (3) sets Lesson Plan fully signed by DepEd representative/s and BFAR representative/s must be submitted (on line -soft copy / hard copy ) a day before the actual demonstration.
- 5. The use of instructional materials must be in its maximum level.
- 6.Post conference shall be done after every demonstration teaching.
- 7. Participants for demonstration teaching shall receive Certificate of Recognition as DEMONSTRATION TEACHER (Regional level).
