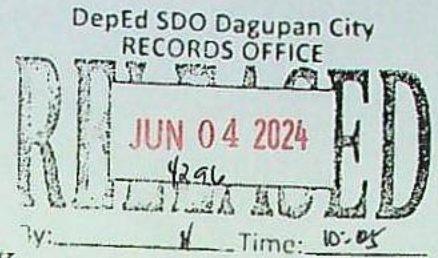

1. The City of Dagupan is celebrating its 77th Founding Anniversary this year. 
