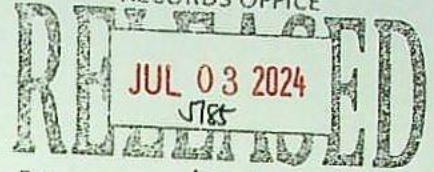



SUBJECT : 14th NATIONAL ROVER MOOT

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines is pleased to announce the conduct of **14th National Rover Moot** on **22-26 July 2024** at **Camp Irosin, Municipality of Irosin, Province of Sorsogon** with the theme "**Sustaining Growth**".
2. **Aim and Objectives.** The 14th National Rover Moot aims to provide safe, exciting, challenging and meaningful learning opportunities and educational activities geared towards responsible leadership, community development, environment and natural resources protection and preservation and build lasting friendship among the Rovers of open-air and service.

At the end of the Rover Moot, the participants should have:

- a. Contributed to the development of local communities through the immersion program, activities and service projects specifically the 2024 Brigada Eskwela;
 - b. Developed awareness about the Environment, Development and Peace Education anchored on the UN Sustainable Development Goals through cooperative learning, teamwork and youth involvement in the Better World Framework;
 - c. Learned, practiced and undertaken campcraft and woodcraft skills for self-reliance; participated in outdoor exploration and high adventure activities;
 - d. Acquired and learned knowledge and skills about the relevant issues and challenges of today's society such as health, education, peace, environment, livelihood, family and human rights forum and dialogue;
 - e. Developed, acquired core life skills and 21st century leadership capabilities through team building, cooperative learning, group dynamics, creative problem-solving and decision-making skills; and
 - f. Strengthened camaraderie and fellowship among the Rovers from different councils nationwide.
3. **Qualifications for Participation.** The following are the minimum qualifications for participating Rovers, Rover Leaders and NSTs, viz:
 - a. **Rover Scouts** are expected to have leadership skills and potentials and enough camping experience;
 - i. Must be currently registered with a Rover Circle in good standing.
 - ii. Must be at least 16 to 26 years old.
 - iii. Must have a Health and Medical Certificate to be Physically Fit as certified by a Licensed Physician.
 - iv. Must have Parent's Permit for participants below 18 years old.
 - v. Must have a complete set of camping gears and equipment.

- b. **Rover Leaders** must have undergone the Basic Training and/or preferably with Advanced Training Course for Unit Leaders and understanding of his/her duties and responsibilities of Adult Leader;
 - i. Must be currently registered with a Rover Circle;
 - ii. Must be physically fit as certified by a physician;
 - iii. Must be of good moral character;
 - iv. Must be equipped with camping gears.
- c. **National Service Team.** Each Scouting Region is allocated with specific quota for Adult Leaders and volunteers who wish to serve as part of the National Service Team.
 - i. Must be currently registered as a Rover Scout or as an Adult Leader aged between 18 to 50 years old.
 - ii. Must be physically fit as certified by a physician.
 - iii. Must be of good moral character.
 - iv. Must be at least a Wood Badge Holder with at least one (1) year of experience and service.
 - v. Must be duly recommended by the Council Scout Executive/Officer-in-Charge and the Regional Youth Development Officer.

4. **Quota for Participation.** The participation to the Rover Moot will come from the 127 Local Councils and 10 Scouting Regions of the BSP and is pro-rated as follows:

- a. **Rovers and Leaders.** A Standard Ratio of One (1) Leader for every nine (9) Rovers must be observed in the composition of Moot Contingents.
 - b. **NSTs.** Each Scouting Region is allocated with specific quota for Adult Leaders and volunteers who wish to serve as part of the National Service Team. NSTs played a significant role in the implementation of the Rover Moot program as well as in the administration support to the Moot Organizers.
5. **Registration Fee.** A registration fee of **Five Hundred Pesos Only (P 500.00)** shall be charged each participant to cover expenses for program materials, certificates, individual souvenir items and other administrative costs during the event.
6. **Remittance of Payment: Inclusive Dates: 15 May to 15 July 2024.** Remittance of registration shall be done in bulk, and only the Local Council is allowed to remit the registration fee. No individual registration fees should be remitted to the Rover Moot account.

Registration fees must be paid directly to the host council via bank transfer **not later than 15 July 2024**, with the following details:

A clear scanned copy of the bank deposit slip must be electronically transmitted to the host council through email address forneozasheryl@gmail.com with a copy furnished to the BSP National Office through bsp@scouts.gov.ph.

THERE WILL BE NO ON SITE REGISTRATION. ONLY THE HOST COUNCIL, SORSOGON COUNCIL, BSP IS AUTHORIZED TO COLLECT AND/OR RECEIVE THE ROVER MOOT REGISTRATION FEE.

Regardless as to whether the total numbers of pre-registered participants have been met or not during the actual conduct of the Rover Moot, the registration fee is not refundable, but is transferrable.

7. **Rover Circle Equipment:** The standard Circle equipment is prescribed in activities of this nature. It is suggested that only handy equipment (tent, cooking gears, sleeping bags, food provisions, uniform, costumes, extra clothes, personal toilet kit, etc.) should be brought by every contingent.
8. **Food Provisions.** The Moot participants of each Local Council must provide for their own food and other basic requirements that will be sufficient throughout the entire duration of the Rover Moot. Each contingent is responsible in managing their respective kitchens, mess and commissaries. Wet and Dry Markets will be made available at the Camp Site in order to ensure the availability of food supplies at reasonable prices.
9. **Travel Itinerary.** All Moot participants are advised to submit their Itinerary of Travel to their respective Regional Youth Development Officers for record and reference purposes. Furthermore, all participants are advised to report at the Rover Moot Site not later than 0900H of 21 July 2024 (Sunday) and will only be cleared to leave the camp after the Grand Closing Ceremony.
10. The Regional Youth Development Officers and Council Scout Executives/Officers-in-Charge are hereby directed to ensure the maximum participation of the Scouts and the Adult Leaders within your respective regions and Local Councils.

SUBJECT : ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR THE 14th NATIONAL ROVER MOOT


1. Relative to the National Office Memorandum No. 35 series 2024 dated April 22, 2024, we wish to provide all concerned with the following additional information for your guidance and reference.
 - a. Travel Advisory
 - a.1. **Land** – Buses from Cubao or Pasay going Bulan or Matnog, Sorsogon for a 12 to 14 hours land travel. Advise the bus operator that the destination will be in Irosin, Sorsogon before Bulan and Matnog, Sorsogon.
 - a.2. **Air** – Flights to Daraga Bicol International Airport are available from NAIA. Land Travel from Bicol International Airiport to Irosin, Sorsogon is almost 2 hours.
 - a.3. **Sea** – Ferries from Samar Port to Matnog takes more than 2 hours while those from Bogo, Cebu will traverse Masbate then Pilar, Sorsogon. Matnog, Sorsogon to Irosin, Sorsogon takes aboutr 30 to 45 minutes while Plar Port to Irosin takes more than one hour.
 - b. **The National Service Team for the Moot will be composed of the National staff, Program Staff of the host Council, and concerned LGUs offices.**
 - c. Things to bring:
 - Tent for the accommodation of their assigned immersion site and in-camp area.
 - Sleeping Bag with a sleeping pad
 - Rover Scout Uniform
 - Daily Clothing (4-5 sets)
 - Hat and Bandana
 - Jacket or sweatshirt
 - Rain gear
 - Water jugs/tumblers
 - Personal eating gear
 - Flashlight/Headlamp with extra batteries
 - Insect repellent

2. All candidates for the Chief Scout National Builder Award must submit all requirements to the Field Operations Division on or before **30 June 2024** to be included in the National Court of Honor on **25 July 2024** during the 14th NRM. No application will be processed during the Moot.
3. **Last day to remit registration fee will be on 30 June 2024**, and only the Local Council is allowed to remit the registration fee. No individual registration fee should be remitted to the Rover Moot Account. Registration fees must be paid directly to the host council via bank transfer, with the following details:
