

This is to inform all concerned that this Office interposes no objection to the request of Rev. Fr. EYMARD MARK MA. GAYOTIN MMHC, Local Pastoral Director of Youth for Mary and Christ-Pangasinan Chapter, re: conduct of catechesis and evangelization among public elementary & secondary schools.

It is emphasized however that the said request is subject to the following guidelines and regulations:

- 1. Participation to the activity is optional and on voluntary basis only;
- 2. Parent's permission is required;
- 3. The schedule of religious instruction which is limited to 30 minutes a week has to be arranged with the School Head concerned and shall be done outside class hours to avoid disruption of classes (DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005, Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith).

YOUTH FOR MARY AND CHRIST IN ACTION

The Youth for Mary and Christ (formerly known as Youth Marian Crusade) is a movement that aims to reawaken the consciences of the youth, particularly in the Public Secondary Schools, and lead them closer to the foot of Christ's cross by instilling in them a greater love for Christ and an authentic devotion to the Blessed Mother. Its main objective is to form fraternal, praying, apostolic and Christian communities within their schools.

To ensure that indeed fraternal, praying, apostolic and Christian communities are being established in their respective school chapters, activities and community gatherings are held to deepen their appreciation of their Christian faith as well as to strengthen the camaraderie among members and their individual commitment.

NATURE OF YMC ACTIVITIES

- Only YMC members are allowed to attend and participate in all online activities and contests organized by the Core Group.
- Teacher-Animators and Student-Trainors are present in all activities to help, supervise, and facilitate in every event.
- 3. Priests and seminarians of the MMHC are the main organizers of every activity.
- 4. A Parent's Permit is always secured from each and every member who wishes to participate any activities online.
- 5. All activities are free of charge.

Some of the major activities to be organized this year are as follows:

GENERAL MARIOLOGY

An assembly of all the active members of the group. To be organized on the month of October, this activity aims to open the members to a bigger family-membership, where they can interact virtually their co-members coming from different school chapters, through their engagements in specific contests.

MONTHLY MEETINGS

A seminarian holds a face-to-face meeting to each and every school chapter assigned to him, once a week, to teach basic catechesis, moral values, and sustain the YMC formed in each school.

FIRST FRIDAY VIGIL

An overnight prayer vigil, where the student-members are taught the values of sacrifice and discipline.

CHRISTMAS PARTY

A celebration of the birth of our Savior, where the members get the chance to enjoy contests and the Funfilled games and activities that add color to this whole day event.

GRAND ROSARY RALLY

This is a grand and special event made in honour of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It intends to inspire the youth and challenge them to be future bearers of the truth and life for the nation.
