

It is emphasized however that the said request is subject to the following guidelines and regulations:

- 1. Participation to the activity is optional and on voluntary basis only;
- 2. Parent's permission is required;
- 3. The schedule of religious instruction which is limited to 30 minutes a week has to be arranged with the School Head concerned and shall be done outside class hours to avoid disruption of classes (DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005, Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith).

To this day, PVEP's teaching of Christian values has been committed to instilling in our children the importance of compassion, forgiveness, honesty, and other values central to the Christian faith universally accepted as good values without violating the principles of neutrality and inclusivity.

As a part of our pledge to support the DepEd's core values (MAKA-DIOS, MAKA-TAO, MAKAKALIKASAN AT MAKABANSA), we humbly request to execute a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the PVEP and the DepEd School Division of Dagupan City as a means to establish a collaborative framework within the jurisdiction of the DepEd School Division Dagupan City to satisfy the critical need for teaching, nurturing, and coaching Christian values among Filipino vouth.
