September 19- Family Day

- Spend quality time with your family by cooking, gardening or preparing snacks together or any other fun things to foster good family relations.
- Hold a Family Day or Family Camp.


September 26 - ESCODA DAY AND GIRL'S DAY- Council level (CSI Stadia)





Contest Guidelines:

1. Music shall be of your own choice. Remix is not allowed as agreed upon during the meeting. Submission of music to the Council shall be 3 days before the event
2. Presentation shall be maximum of five (5) minutes including entrance and exit.
3. There shall be no props except for the Junior Category. However, accenting the attire is allowed.
4. Stunts and acrobatic moves are not allowed. Sexy moves, censored and double meaning lyrics/music during the presentation are also discouraged.
5. Fire crackers, smoke (natural or artificial), explosives or breakable materials or any hazardous materials that are detrimental to the participants and audience are strictly prohibited.
6. Maximum participation in all categories is highly encouraged.
7. The judges decision is final and irrevocable.
