ONLINE SURVEY ON THE P7,000.00 MEDICAL ALLOWANCE

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Chiefs of Functional Divisions

- Under Executive Order No. 64, s. 2024, signed by President Ferdinand Marcos, Jr., the government will provide an annual medical allowance of up to P7,000.00 to eligible government civilian personnel, including public school teachers starting 2025.
- This allowance is intended to subsidize the cost of health maintenance organization (HMO)-type benefits. The medical allowance can be used for various medical services, helping public employees be prepared for any health-related emergencies.
- In view thereto, the Employee Welfare Division (EWD) conducts an online survey to assess the preference and generate feedback from DepEd employees on the availment of medical services, as well as to gather baseline data on HMO and other health insurance needs.


