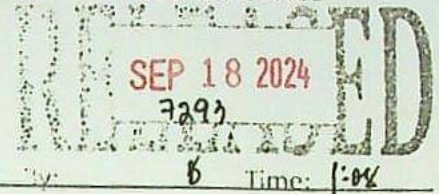

**2024 NATIONAL SCIENCE CLUB MONTH (NSCM) CELEBRATION**

1. As mandated by Presidential Proclamation No. 264 dated September 23, 2002, the National Science Club Month (NSCM) is celebrated every September. It is a month long event in which Science enthusiasts are encouraged to participate. This year's NSCM theme is drawn from the Department of Science and Technology's (DOST) celebration of National Science and Technology Week: *Siyensya, Teknolohiya at Inobasyon: Kabalikat sa Matatag, Maginhawa, at Panatag na Kinabukasan.*"
2. The purpose of celebrating this year's theme is to emphasize the vital role of science, technology, and innovation in fostering a strong, comfortable, and secure future. It aims to inspire greater participation and awareness among students, educators, and science enthusiasts, highlighting the importance of these fields in nation building and improving the quality of life for all. Through various activities, the celebration seeks to encourage curiosity, learning, and innovation to address current and future challenges.
3. All schools are hereby encouraged to participate and come up with meaningful and significant activities related to the theme.
4. In all activities to be undertaken in the school in connection with the celebration of NSCM, the *no disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith* must be observed. The activities should be organized in a manner that does not interrupt the regular class schedules. Schools are encouraged



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

to incorporate the celebration into the existing class activities or after-school periods.

5. A culminating program will be held from September 30 to October 1, 2024, featuring a two-day training-workshop on Robotics and Science Investigatory Projects at a venue to be announced later.
6. Science Coordinators are expected to prepare narrative reports on the innovations and activities conducted. The submission of report will be on or before October 11, 2024 through a link to be provided later.
7. All expenses related to the conduct of the celebration of the National Science Club Month shall be charged to the school MOOE/local funds or other source of fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
