








#### REGIONAL TRAINING ON HIGHER ORDER THINKING SKILLS - PROFESSIONAL LEARNING PACKAGES (HOTS-PLPS) FOR GRADES 9 TO 10 SCIENCE TEACHERS

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- The Department of Education, through the Human Resource Development Division - National Educators Academy of the Philippines- Region I (HRDD-NEAP RI), shall conduct the Regional Training on Higher Order Thinking Skills - Professional Learning Packages (HOTS-PLPs) for Grades 9 to 10 Science Teachers at NEAP R1, San Vicente, City of San Fernando La Union on October 14-18, 2024.
- The activity aims to:
  - a. support the teachers in understanding HOTS and in reflecting these skills in their respective classroom practices through the development of HOTS items/questions for Science subject;
