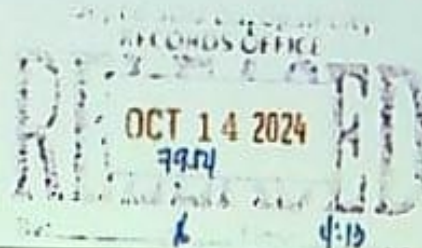

**NATIONAL TRAINING OF SPORTS CLUB FACILITATORS ON THE TEACHING OF
SPORTS SPECIFIC SKILLS**

1. The Department of Education's Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Sports Division (BLISS-SSD) is focused on establishing School Sports Clubs to promote physical fitness, health, and engagement among learners. It is also an avenue for learners to discover and develop their sports potentials.
2. In line with the implementation of the DepEd Sports Manual that provides essential guides and instructions for the School Sports Club Program, a Sports Training Program for Cluster I will be conducted from October 21-25, 2024 at Teacher's Camp, Baguio City.
3. The sessions will underscore the importance of sports in addressing the developmental needs of learners, facilitating their engagement in physical activities to promote health and growth.
4. The training for sports club facilitators will cover Arnis, Dancesport, Pencak Silat, Table Tennis, Sepaktakraw, and Wushu. Two (2) facilitators to be designated for School Sports (per sports), who possess knowledge of their chosen sport. Preferably MAPEH teacher, former student-athlete, or with experience in sports activities.




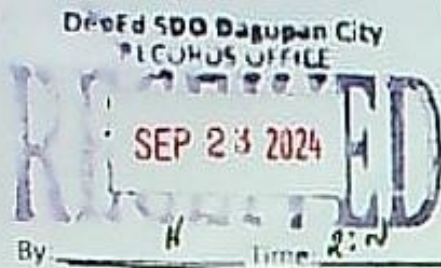

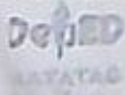

DATE : September 9, 2024

In line with the Department of Education's (DepEd) mission to foster holistic learner development, the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Sports Division (BLSS-SSD) is dedicated to enhancing this agenda through sports and physical activities. Active engagement in these areas is recognized as crucial to the comprehensive development of learners. To support this, the BLSS-SSD is focused on establishing School Sports Clubs to promote physical fitness, health, and engagement among learners. It is also an avenue for learners to discover and develop their sports potentials. In relation, this Office has developed the DepEd Sports Manual covering thirty (30) sports including paragames.

The DepEd Sports Manual provides essential guides and instructions for the School Sports Club Program, aiming to improve learners' skills across different sports disciplines. To implement this, Sports Skills Training sessions will be conducted from October 2024 onwards at Teacher's Camp, Baguio City, and the training shall be divided into five (5) clusters. This initiative is designed to equip participants with the necessary skills and knowledge for effective sports management and to highlight the role of sports in learner development. In addition, this training will impart best practices, techniques, and values across various sports, thereby empowering participants with confidence and competence needed to lead and support capacity building efforts among other sports stakeholders. These sessions will underscore the importance of sports in addressing the developmental needs of learners, facilitating their engagement in physical activities to promote health and growth.
