- Due to weather disturbance experienced last week, the Schools Division Office of Dagupan City through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) announces the postponement of the conduct of 2024-2025 Division Schools Press Conference on November 4-6, 2024 to provide enough preparation for the event.
- 2. The sealing and checking of laptop, equipment, and camera shall take place on October 29 for private elementary and secondary schools and October 30 for all public elementary and secondary schools. The same schedule stipulated in DM no. 399, s.2024 shall be followed. Ensure that laptops are cleared with videos, documents, photos and images that were used during rehearsals or training practices. Only the sealed and checked contest equipment and gadgets are allowed to use during the competition.
- 3. Due to unavoidable circumstances and judges' unavailability on some dates, here is the new schedule to follow for the individual and group contests.

- 4. Mini-press conference and live sports coverage shall be conducted right after the opening program. Participants for online publishing, collaborative desktop publishing, sports writing including photojournalism should be at the venue at 10 o'clock in the morning for briefing and orientation.
- 5. On the second day of the event, assembly time for radio broadcaster-participants is 7AM while TV broadcaster-participants call time is 9AM for general orientation and briefing prior to the contest proper.
- 6. Other participants in other various individual and group contests may come to the venue 1 hour before the actual contest proper.

- 8. Used flash drives and memory/SD Cards can still be utilized during the competition provided that it is checked and inspected by the committee on sealing and checking prior to the contest proper.
- 9. In Photojournalism, the contestants are allowed to use any digital camera or DSLR with fixed lens. Also, for Online Publishing, the use of DSLR cameras is allowed.
- 10. In the individual contests, students need NOT to bring and use laptop when writing
- 11. All group events except online publishing shall compose of seven (7) members.
- 12. Deadline for submission of pertinent papers for the Search for Most Outstanding School Paper Advisers (MOSPA) and Most Outstanding Campus Journalist (MOCJ) is on October 31 at 8AM. Please submit it at CID Office c/o Dr. Gemma M. Erfelo and Dr. Agnes B. Royulada.
