CONDUCT OF SCHOOL-BASED IN-SERVICE TRAINING (INSET)

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors Public Schools District Supervisors Education Program Supervisors School Heads Others concerned

- In view of the upcoming Midyear School Break scheduled on November 25-29, 2024, this office enjoined all school heads to submit their Professional Development Program and other required enclosures, that encompasses a blend of professional development and assessment of programs, projects, and activities (PPAs).
- 2. A three (3)-day school-based In-Service-Training shall provide teachers with opportunities for ongoing professional growth in accordance with the guidelines issued by the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) on the conduct of INSET and the preparation of instructional materials.
- Topics for School-Based INSET shall be aligned with any of the following priority programs:
 - a. MATATAG Curriculum for Kindergarten and Grades 1, 4, and 7;
 - b. National Learning Camp;
 - c. National Reading Program;
 - d. National Mathematics Program;
 - e. Inclusive Education (Alternative Learning System, Indigenous Peoples Education, Madrasah Education Program, Special Needs Education, etc.);
 - f. Comprehensive Sexuality Education (DepEd Order No. 031, s. 2018);
 - g. Gender and Development;
 - h. Induction Program for Beginning Teachers;
