GENERAL RULES AND GUIDELINES

1. The theme for this year's Filipino Values Month Celebration is "Pagsusulong ng Bagong Pilipinas: Ang Kabataan Bilang Pundasyon ng Pagbabago"
2. All participants must be bonafide junior high school students of SDO Dagupan City. Strictly one (1) representative per secondary school.
3. The participants should be registered prior to the contest proper.
4. There will be no multiple registrations for the contests will be held simultaneously. A student can only join a single contest.
5. Strictly follow the guidelines, mechanics and criteria for judging.
6. Violations to the rules & guidelines will lead to the disqualification of contestant.

PAGSULAT NG SANAYSAY

1. Each school will be represented by one participant (JHS).
2. The essay, with relevance to the theme should be composed of 200-250 words in Filipino.
3. The topic will be given on the spot.
4. One hour and thirty minutes will be allotted for the participants to work on their piece.
5. Contestants are not allowed to use their cellphones during the contest proper.

Criteria for judging:

Nilalaman (kaugnayan sa paksa)	30%
Organisasyon (pagkakasunud-sunod ng talata)	30%
Pagiging orihinal	30%
Pagkamalikhain at kalinisan	10%

PAGGAWA NG POSTER



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1. Each school will be represented by one participant (JHS)
2. The participants should provide their own drawing materials except the ½ (15 x 20 inches) illustration board which will be provided by the contest organizers. Oil pastel will be the only medium allowed but lead pencil and ruler can be used as a guide.
3. The theme will be given on the spot.
4. Two hours will be allotted for the participants to work on their piece.
5. Contestants are not allowed to use their cellphones during contest proper.

Criteria for judging

Relevance to the theme	30%
Originality	20%
Craftsmanship	20%
Color Combination	20%
Over-all impact	10%

SPOKEN WORD POETRY

1. The contest is open to junior high school students within Dagupan City Division and each school shall register only one contestant.
2. The spoken poetry must be an original composition and must be written in Filipino.
3. The piece must be related to the theme. Indicate a title for your piece.
4. Three (3) printed copies of the spoken poetry must be submitted to the organizers upon registration.
5. It must be delivered from memory and any movement must be confined onstage.
6. Each contestant is given a time limit of 3-5 minutes to recite or deliver the piece. If the delivery is less than 3 minutes or if it exceeds 5 minutes, there will be one-point deduction from the total score.
7. Attire appropriate for the spoken poetry should be worn during the contest.



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8. Sounds, instrumental or musical background are allowed to complement the delivery. No deduction shall be made if the contestant opts not to have a musical background.
9. While waiting for their turn, contestants will stay in the designated holding area and are not allowed to bring their cellphones.

Criteria for judging:

- A. Message/Content (40%)
 - The content must be relevant to the theme.
 - It has powerful & meaningful message.
- B. Delivery and Performance (30%)
 - It was delivered from the heart.
 - There's connection to the audience.
 - Facial expressions, hand and body gestures were used accordingly.
 - Audience's attention and interest were captured and sustained.
 - Audience can understand what is being spoken.
 - Words were pronounced distinctly and correctly. Does not stutter nor stammer
 - Pronunciation and intonation sound natural
- C. Voice Variation and Projection (15%)
 - Voice is modulated
 - Spoke loudly and clearly enough for listeners to hear and understand
 - Voice projects confidence and conviction
- D. Memorization (10%)
 - The piece was effectively recited from memory
 - Freestyle or improvisation was spontaneous even if a word or line is forgotten
- E. Attire (5%)
 - It complements the contestant's spoken piece

VALUES TIKTOK CHALLENGE

1. The contest is open to junior high school students within Dagupan City Division and each school shall register only one entry.
2. Tiktok presentation must portray the theme – “Ang Kabataan Bilang Pundasyon ng Pagbabago”.
3. Each group composed of 3-5 members must create a video using the Tiktok app with a time limit of 2-3 minutes. A one-point deduction from the total score will be given for every exceeding minute.
4. Video content must be original.
5. The presentation can be a performance of dance, song, acting or a combination.



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6. The use of appropriate sound and clothing is a must. No profanity, No inappropriate language, inappropriate skit/dance/appearance, No inappropriate gestures and No vulgar words.
7. The use of costumes and props is allowed.
8. The recorded Tiktok video must be sent on or before December 4, 2024, 5:00 PM to a link to be provided.

<i>Creativity & Execution-</i>	- 30%
<i>Message</i>	- 20%
<i>Over-all Impact-</i>	- 10%

BIBLE QUIZ BEE

1. The contest is open to junior high school students within Dagupan City Division and each school shall register only one entry/group composed of four members. (1 Gr. 7, 1 Gr. 8, 1 Gr. 9 & 1 Gr. 10)
2. The Bible Quiz will be composed of three rounds – easy, average and difficult rounds.
3. All questions will be specifically coming from the Four Gospels – Matthew, Mark, Luke and John using the New International Version.
4. All rounds will be conducted through a board raising scheme.
5. The following point system will be followed:
Easy round – 1 point per question (10 questions)
Average round - 2 points per question (10 questions)
Difficult round - 3 points per question (10 questions)
6. All questions will only be read twice. The following time limit will be followed:
Easy round – 15 seconds per identification question, 10 seconds for multiple choice
Average round - 15 seconds per identification question, 10 seconds for multiple choice
Difficult - 20 seconds per identification question, 15 seconds for multiple choice
7. Participants are allowed to write on their illustration boards only when the quiz master gives the “go” signal after reading the question.
8. The three individuals with the highest cumulative scores will be awarded as First Place, Second Place and Third Place, respectively.
9. In case of a tie, a 30-second clincher question shall be asked. The first participant to get the correct answer shall emerge as the winner.
10. Only the official contestants may raise a complaint or clarification.
11. Complaints on a given question should be made before the next question is asked. This should be directed to the judges.
12. The decision of the technical judges is final and irrevocable.
