Presiding Leader: February 22nd of each year is a day filled with meaningful thoughts from Girl Guides and Girl Scouts all over the world.. Today, we honor the joint birthdays of Lord Baden Powell, the founder of Scouting, and Lady Olave, our World Chief Guide, whose lives of love and service we remember with gratitude.. Our thoughts link us ever strongly in what Olave Baden Powell calls the "Golden Chain" that shines out in a world of uncertainty and fear. The work begun by them is now our privilege to enjoy and our responsibility to continue.

SPEAKER 1: As part of our celebration, we have placed here the symbol of Thinking Day which has the World Trefoil in the center of the design representing the World Association of Girl Guldes and Girl Scouts.

The arrow pointing towards the trefoil represent action and give direction for that action. The arrows also represent ways and means in which the World Association can be helped by its members. The round shape of the design can be interpreted as the worldwide aspect of the movement.

SPEAKER 2: The world is full of thoughts, but it is through our deeds that we are best remembered. Let us pause for a minute and recall the Girl Scouts and Girl Guides whom we know and their work towards cooperation and understanding. (silence). Shoulder to shoulder, the youth of the world since marched on the trail that our beloved Founder laid so long ago. Let us think of those girls whose lives were changed because of Girl Scouting. On this special day, we remember —

- That in the fellowship of Girl Guldes and Girl Scouts, we have sisters in 154 countries worldwide
- That we and all our sister scouts can be a strong force for peace in the world.
- That we are great in numbers, so we must be great in loyalty to our ideals.

SPEAKER 3: Oh God, who art the Father of all people in the world, we pray for thy blessings. We turn to Thee for wisdom to choose the right way, for strength to walk in it, for love to share with all of us, as we travel the way of life. Help us to live that by the example of your love, we may encourage other to spread the joy and peace among nations, and so bring nearer the day when all people shall be brother and sisters in the fellowship of Thy kingdom.

Almighty God, Father of all your children, we ask your blessings on the Girl Guldes/ Girl Scouts of the world. SPEAKER 4(School Head): Thinking Day gives us a major opportunity to help each other through our voluntary efforts. Every centavo that we share will go a long way to support Girl Guiding and Girl Scouting Programs all over the world. The World Thinking Day Fund help girls' voices to be heard globally, have access to unique and empowering non-formal educational experiences and delivers leadership training to young women.
