1. An effective School Governance Council (SGC) requires active engagement from both internal and external stakeholders. Collaborative and harmonious relationships between the school and its stakeholders are reinforced when responsibilities are shared, delegated, and decisions are made through consultation.
2. To enhance SGC functionality, the Bureau of Human Resource and Organizational Development-School Effectiveness Division (BHROD-SED) has developed and rolled out an assessment tool.
