- To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Functional Division - CID & SGOD Education Program Supervisors Public Schools District Supervisors SDO Section Heads and Unit Heads Elementary and Secondary School Heads Teachers and All Others Concerned
 - 1. The Schools Division Office (SDO) of Dagupan City recognizes the critical role of research in enhancing education quality, informing policy, and strengthening school systems. Amid ongoing shifts in technology, health, climate, and learner needs, research must be evidence-based, relevant, and responsive to local contexts.
 - 2. Aligned with the Basic Education Development Plan (BEDP) 2030, the MATATAG Agenda, and DepEd Order No. 16, s. 2017, the Division affirms its commitment to utilizing research to improve teaching, learning, governance, and learner outcomes.
 - 3. The Division Research Agenda 2025-2030 serves as a guide for all teaching and nonteaching personnel in preparing and conducting action and basic research. It addresses priority local concerns and supports inclusive, resilient, and future-ready schools.
 - 4. Specifically, the Agenda aims to:
 - a. Promote a strong and sustainable research culture across schools and offices;

b. Address pressing and emerging educational issues through research-based solutions;

c. Support planning, policy-making, and continuous improvement through research utilization; and

d. Encourage collaboration and partnerships for greater research impact.







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- 5. All research proposals must align with the Division, Regional and National Research Agenda and undergo screening by the Schools Division Research Committee (SDRC).
- 6. Division Research Agenda 2025-2030 is attached as Annex A for reference and guidance. All concerned are encouraged to initiate research aligned with the agenda and the strategic directions of the Division, the Department of Education, and national development goals.
- 7. The agenda will be reviewed annually to ensure relevance and effectiveness. Monitoring shall include:
 - a. Regular updating based on trends and policy directions;
 - b. Tracking of completed, ongoing, and proposed research;
 - c. Assessment of research utilization and impact; and
 - d. Alignment with the Division Education Development Plan (DEDP).
