4. Event shirts shall be distributed on March 3, 2026 prior to the parade assembly.





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


Girls on Fire: Ultimate Band Clash

(Inter-School Girl Group Band Competition)

I. OBJECTIVE

The competition aims to:

- Showcase the musical talent and creativity of young girls.
- Promote confidence, teamwork, and leadership.
- Celebrate girl empowerment through music.
- Encourage positive and inspiring performances aligned with the theme "*Empowered Girls, Empowered Futures.*"

II. ELIGIBILITY

1. Open to all public and private elementary and secondary schools.
2. Participants must be female students aged 17 years old and below.
3. Each school may field one (1) band only.
4. Each band must have 4-8 members
5. A school adviser/coach must accompany the group during the event.

III. PERFORMANCE GUIDELINES

1. Each band must perform:
 - o One (1) OPM or English song (empowerment-themed encouraged)
 - o Song must be appropriate for a school audience
2. Performance time limit.
 - o Minimum: 4 minutes
 - o Maximum: 7 minutes
3. Exceeding the time limit will result in point deductions
4. Bands may use:
 - o Live instruments (drums, guitar, bass, keyboard, etc.)
 - o Backing tracks are allowed but must not overpower live vocals
5. Vulgar lyrics, offensive gestures, or inappropriate attire are strictly prohibited.
6. Costumes/outfits must be decent and age-appropriate.

IV. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Basic sound system will be provided by the organizer.
2. Bands must bring their own instruments (except drum set if provided).
3. Sound check schedule will be assigned prior to the competition.
4. Failure to appear during the assigned sound check may result in technical adjustments during performance only.

1. The poster must clearly reflect the theme of girl empowerment, equality, protection, leadership, and confidence.
2. Posters must be done on:
 - o 1/2 illustration board
3. Any medium may be used (crayons, oil pastel, watercolor, acrylic, colored pencils, mixed media).
4. Posters must be original and handmade.
 - o Tracing, printed images, and AI-generated designs are strictly prohibited.
5. Participants will be given 1 to 2 hours to complete their artwork.
6. Only official materials brought by the participant are allowed.
7. The participant's name, school, and category must be written at the back of the poster.
8. All artworks become property of the organizers and may be displayed during the celebration.
9. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.

Theme: *Lead like the Babaylans, Filipinas!*

I. Eligibility

1. Open to all female students officially enrolled in participating schools.
2. Each group must have 5-8 members only.
3. Participants must register through their school coordinator on or before the given deadline.
4. Each group may have one coach/adviser only.

II. Contest Mechanics

1. The dance presentation must reflect the theme of girl empowerment, unity, confidence, and resilience.
2. Performance time must be 3-5 minutes only.
 - o A deduction of 2 points will be given for every 30 seconds exceeding the time limit.
3. Any dance genre is allowed (hip-hop, contemporary, cultural, jazz, etc.).
4. Music must be submitted in MP3 format at least 1 day before the competition.
5. Costumes must be:
 - o Decent and age-appropriate
 - o Respectful and aligned with the theme
6. Use of simple props is allowed, but must be easy to set up and remove within 1 minute.
7. Dangerous stunts or lifts that may cause injury are strictly prohibited.
8. Performance order will be determined through a draw lots system.
9. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.

III. Criteria for Judging (100%)

- **Choreography & Creativity - 30%**
(Originality, formation, transitions, use of space)
- **Execution & Synchronization - 30%**
(Timing, coordination, mastery of routine)
- **Stage Presence & Energy - 20%**
(Confidence, facial expression, audience impact)
- **Relevance to Theme - 15%**
(Message of empowerment clearly shown)
- **Costume & Overall Impact - 5%**

6. Plagiarized entries will automatically be disqualified.
7. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.
