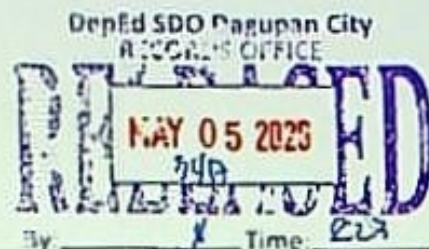

1. In reference to DepEd Order No. 47, s. 2014 and DepEd Order No. 11, s. 2016, the Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) and Supreme Student Learner Government (SSLG) are the primary co-curricular student organization authorized to implement pertinent programs, projects, and activities which helps the Department of Education (DepEd) achieve its thrusts as indicated in the Education for all (EFA) goals, Millenium Development Goals (MDGs) and the K-12 Program.
2. Relative to this, the Schools Division Office through the Youth Formation Unit will be conducting a Division Youth Leadership Training Camp 2026 entitled "Kampsama 2026: Strong Minds, Strong Learners, Breaking the Stigma Together" at Teachers' Camp, Baguio City on May 29-31, 2026.
3. This three-day division wide leadership training camp will focused on strengthening SELG, SSLG, Yes-O and BKD officers and their teacher-advisers' capacities in Psychological First-Aid, Basic Life Support, and SDG-aligned leadership in planning and implementing responsive, inclusive and sustainable learner-led initiatives within their respective schools and communities.
4. Participants to this leadership training are the officers and teacher-advisers of the SELG, SSLG, Yes-O and BKD of Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools. The registration fee, transportation and other incidental expense may be charged to School MOOE/local funds subject to budgeting, accounting and auditing rules and regulations.






6. Each school may send a minimum of two (2) student participants for SELG and (3) student participants for SSLG, along with their respective teacher-advisers.
7. All teacher-adviser participants shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 titled "Granting of Vacation Service Credits for Teachers. Compensatory Time-Off shall be granted to teaching-related and non-teaching personnel in lieu of activity dates that fall on weekends and holidays accordance with the CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004.
8. Enclosed is the parental consent to be signed by parents/ guardians.
