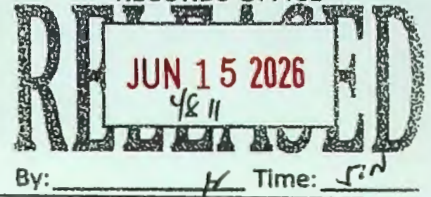

ENHANCING INSTRUCTIONAL LEADERSHIP ON MFAT IMPLEMENTATION

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 29, s. 2018, which institutionalizes the use of the Multi-Factored Assessment Tool (MFAT) for the early identification and appropriate support of learners with diverse educational needs, the Schools Division Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division, will conduct the activity "Enhancing Instructional Leadership on MFAT Implementation." This will be held on July 9, 2026, from 8:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. at the 4th Floor Main Building, Schools Division Office of Dagupan City.
2. This activity aims to strengthen the understanding and implementation of MFAT among education leaders and reinforce collaborative instructional leadership in ensuring its effective and sustained utilization across schools.
3. To achieve its purpose, the activity shall:
 - a. Explain the policy guidelines and purpose of MFAT;
 - b. Identify the roles and responsibilities of education leaders in MFAT implementation;
 - c. Apply MFAT results in guiding instructional decisions and interventions;
 - d. Provide appropriate technical assistance to teachers and schools; and
 - e. Promote coordinated implementation and monitoring of MFAT.
4. Participants to this activity are the Public Elementary School Heads, Public Schools District Supervisors and Facilitators.
5. Expenses relative to the conduct of this activity, amounting to Twenty-Seven Thousand Pesos (P27,000.00), shall be charged against FY 2026 GAA funds for SNED, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The




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amount shall cover the provision of morning snacks and lunch for the participants.
