**ESTABLISHMENT OF BARANGAY READING HUBS UNDER
PROJECT ONE: DAGUPAN**

1. In line with the launch of our Division Flagship Initiative, Project ONE: DAGUPAN (*Optimizing Networks for Excellence: Developing Achievers through Guided, Unified Partnerships and Academic Nobility*) last May 14, 2026, at the Division Training Center with Mayor Belen T. Fernandez as Guest of Honor, this Office is determined to strengthen community partnerships to address reading gaps.
2. Recognizing that many struggling readers have parents who work long hours or lack the capacity to tutor at home, the responsibility of reading remediation must be shared with the community.
3. Therefore, all Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads are directed to coordinate immediately with their respective Barangay Councils and Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) Chairpersons to establish neighborhood-based **Barangay Reading Hubs**.
4. The division of responsibilities shall be as follows:
 - The School: Provide reading materials (such as *Marungko* and *Fuller* tools) and conduct a brief orientation for the volunteer tutors.
 - The Barangay Council: Provide a safe venue (Barangay Hall or Day Care Center) every Friday afternoon (Suggested time: 3:00 PM - 5:00 PM) or Saturday morning (Suggested time: 8:30 AM - 10:30 AM) to address low attendance of struggling learners in school and to establish shared responsibility for our quest on addressing literacy gaps.

- The Sangguniang Kabataan (SK): Mobilize SK officials and youth volunteers to act as READ-bassadors or Ate and Kuya tutors who will directly guide the children.
5. Other related assistance to the success of Project ONE: DAGUPAN from the Brgy. Captains and Sangguniang Kabataan Chairpersons will be greatly appreciated.
 6. School Heads must submit a brief status report of their established partnerships to EPS Agnes Royulada on or before July 16, 2026.
 7. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
