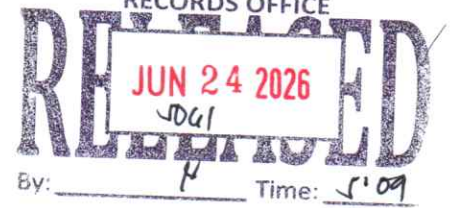

CONDUCT OF DEWORMING OF ALL LEARNERS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2026–2027

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief Education Supervisors
Education Program Supervisors
Public School District Supervisors
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All others concerned

1. With reference to the policy objectives of deworming program under **DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2016**, which states that, *“at least eighty-five percent (85%) of all learners shall be dewormed semi-annually (July 2026 and January 2027),”* this office announces the conduct of the **School-Based Deworming Tablet Administration** for School Year 2026–2027.
2. The activity aims to prevent and control the occurrence of soil- transmitted helminth infections among school- age children, hence helps in promoting good health and in maintaining normal nutritional status level.
3. Anent this, the following activities will be observed:
 - a. Classroom advisers will prepare the master list of learners who will participate in the activity.
 - b. Parental consent shall be secured and collected prior to the administration of deworming tablets. Only learners with signed parental consent forms shall be given the Albendazole drug.



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- c. Schools will coordinate with their assigned Division Nurse regarding their proposed schedule of deworming to ensure proper monitoring of the activity.
- d. After the conduct of the School-Based Deworming Activity, schools will submit a hard copy of the summarized Accomplishment Report, duly signed by the Coordinator and the School Head, to the School Health and Nutrition Unit (SHNU). Likewise, schools will encode and submit the required data through the link provided to facilitate timely consolidation of reports:


