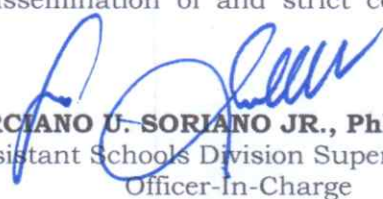
1. To continually strengthen early grade literacy, enhance foundational reading skills, and align pedagogical practices with evidence-based approaches, the Schools Division Office (SDO) of Dagupan City, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), will conduct the **Training on the Science of Reading for Kindergarten to Grade 3 Teachers** on **July 25, 2026**, from **8:00 AM to 5:00 PM**, at the **Division Training Center (DTC)**.
2. The activity aims to equip educators with tailored instructional strategies designed to develop phonological awareness, oral language, vocabulary, print awareness, and alphabetic knowledge.

The Resource Speaker for this training is **Mrs. Rizalina "Sally" Labanda**, Vice President for Teaching and Research of the Association of Fil-Am Teachers of America - New York Philippines Chapter (AFTA INC NY / AFTA PCI).

3. Each school shall send 4 participants (5 for big schools) to the said training. Please see attached list.
4. Since the training falls on a **Saturday**, participating teaching personnel shall be granted **One (1) Day Service Credit** upon submission of the required documentation, pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 (*Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers*).

Non-teaching personnel and facilitators shall be entitled to **Compensatory Time-Off (CTO)** in accordance with existing CSC-DBM Joint Circulars.

5. Immediate and wide dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
