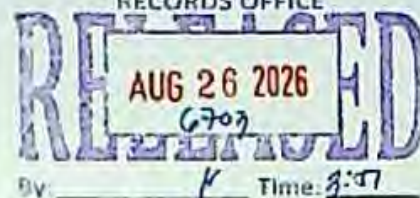

**DIVISION ROLL-OUT ON THE IMPLEMENTATION GUIDELINES OF
DEPED MEMORANDUM NO. 048, S. 2026: ALLOCATION AND RELEASE OF THE
SCHOOL INNOVATION AND IMPROVEMENT FUND TO NON-IMPLEMENTING UNIT
PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO STRENGTHEN DECENTRALIZATION PRACTICES
IN THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026**

1. The Schools Division Office, through the School Governance Operations Division (SGOD), shall conduct a **Division Roll-Out** on the Implementation Guidelines of *DepEd Memorandum No. 048, S. 2026: Allocation and Release of the School Innovation and Improvement Fund to Non-Implementing Unit Public Schools to Strengthen Decentralization Practices in the Department of Education for Fiscal Year 2026* on **August 27, 2026**, at 1:00 PM, at the Division Training Center.

2. The activity aims to:

- 2.1 Discuss the key provisions of the FY 2026 SIIF implementation guidelines;
- 2.2 Explain the implementation arrangements, including the roles and responsibilities of concerned stakeholders;
- 2.3 Demonstrate the basic navigation and use of the SIIF Online Monitoring Tool through the InsightED platform; and
- 2.4 Clarify questions, issues, and concerns related to the implementation, utilization, monitoring, and reporting of the SIIF.

3. The participants shall be the **School Heads of Non-Implementing Unit Public Schools** identified as FY 2026 SIIF recipient schools. In case the School Head is unable to attend, an authorized representative may participate, subject to proper coordination with the SGOD-SMME Unit.

4. Participants are required to bring the following for the hands-on navigation and demonstration of the SIIF Online Monitoring Tool through the InsightED platform:

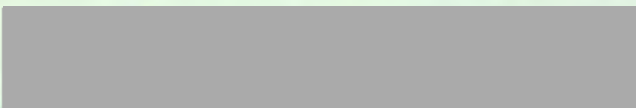
- 4.1 Laptop;
